allows students in dance, dramatic arts, music or visual arts to develop their talents while earning two credits each year.

Guest performers are frequently invited into the classrooms or studios.

"We have a school within a school," said vice-principal Simon Schreiber. There are about 500 Arts York students at the school, which has a student population of 2,083, more than any other school in the region.

CLARIFICATION

The new 14-room addition to the school includes two science labs, computer labs and a cross-curriculum room that can be used to teach history, geography and other subjects.

Last summer, major renovations were completed for the comtech department allowing students to learn digital video editing. Film editing will be offered next year.

The addition came on the heels of harmful mould being discovered in the portables about three years ago.

The efforts of the school council to highlight the issue drew attention to the state of the portables and the need for more permanent space.

Among its activities, the school council hosts annual volunteer fairs where students can find out what each agency's requirements are for their volunteers, said council vice-chair Stevie Joy. It has also worked to develop a dress code for students.

Graduates from the computer graphics and animation department have the qualifications to apply to Sheridan College's



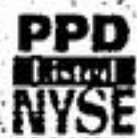

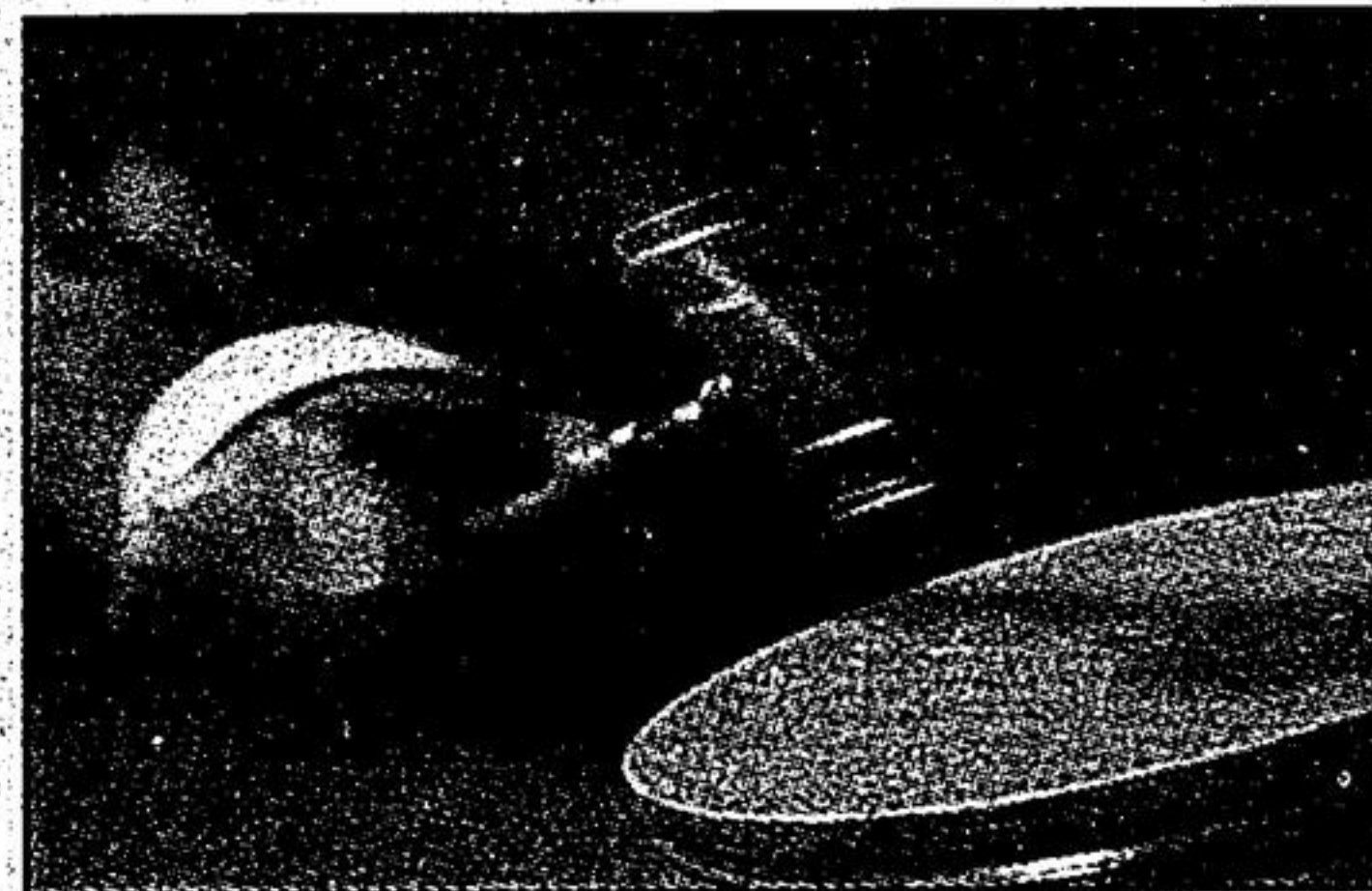
