Focus on Faith

Why do Bad Things Happen to Good People?

It's a question as old as human history: "Why do bad things happen to good people?"

Is trouble God's punishment? Is it just part of living? Or, can there be something of value in having to endure hardship?

The oldest book of the Bible recounts the struggle Job had with this bewildering enigma. Does Biblical teaching shed any light on pain and suffering? In fact, the Scriptures do include numerous examples of

godly people who experienced times of suffering for a variety of reasons.

On the positive side, Romans 8:28 suggests that there may be benefit derived from suffering. Hebrews 12 indicates that there may be personal development from the experiencing of painful occasions in life. Psalm 23, perhaps the best known Psalm in the Bible, gives us assurance that God will stand by us in our distress. But, for many of us, these positive suggestions seem irrelevant

while going through the anguish of mistreatment, hardship and deprivation.

"A Biblical Understanding of Suffering" will be the focus of a workshop being presented by guest speaker Dan Epp-Tiessen of Canadian Mennonite University at Wideman Mennonite Church this weekend, Saturday and Sunday, April 13 and 14. Professor Epp-Tiessen will share from his personal story of what sustained and nurtured him through the experience of being a father to son Timothy, a delightful child who struggled with physical and mental disabilities and who died of cancer at the age of eight.

Saturday's sessions will deal with "Christian Approaches to Pain and Suffering" (10:00am - 12:00pm) and "How We Can Live With Pain and Suffering" (1-3pm).

Sunday's sessions will be held during the worship hours: "Pain and Suffering Transformed" (9:45 am) and "Bringing Our Woundedness to the Cross" (10:50 am).

These seminars are open to any friends of the York Region area. Lunch will be provided both days, April 13 and 14, for those attending the sessions. There is no charge to attend, however, there will be a free will offering to cover costs for the weekend.
