

Unionville High students test their robot against the best

With three Canadian championships under their belts, the members of Unionville High School's robotics team decided it was time to test their mettle against the best in the U.S.

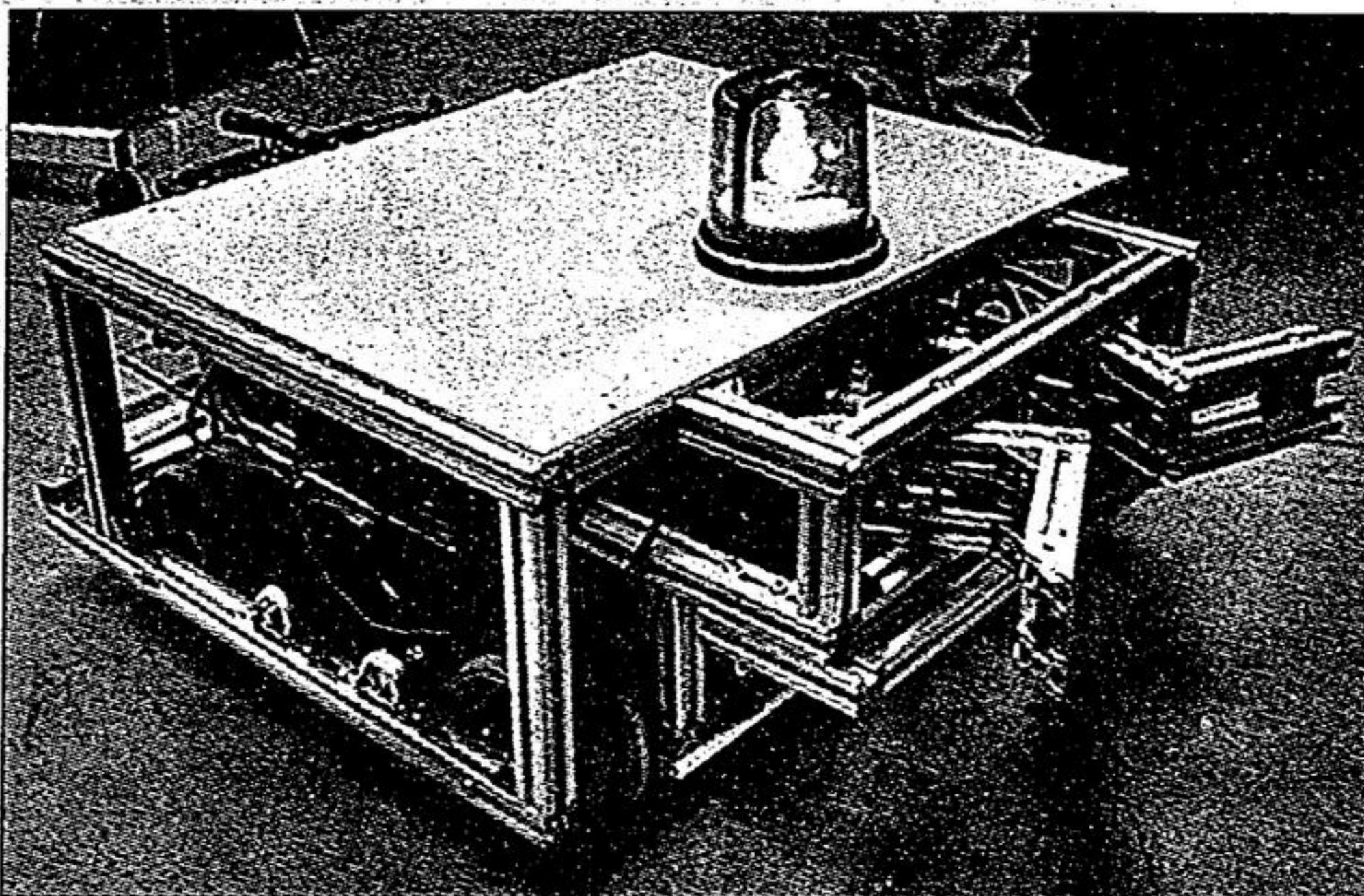
The 33 students placed their faith in a remote-control robot designed and constructed earlier this year. However, due to mechanical problems the team lost in the quarter finals.

"We basically won every award at Canada FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) and wanted to try something new, so we set our sights on Florida (where the U.S. finals are held)," said Jerry Berridge, a UHS communication technology teacher. The team plans to compete again next year.

Over a six-week period, nine girls and 24 boys, Grades 9 to OAC, spent about 35 hours per week creating the robot under the guidance of Mr. Berridge and electronics teacher Tom Hopkins. Like all the robots entered in the FIRST competition, it's designed to play Zone Zeal, a two-minute game with balls and nets.

"I learned time management skills because we had a lot of work to do in a short time," said Grade 12 student Tom Fairley, 17.

More than \$23,000 was spent on production, not including the \$8,000 entrance fee, said Mr. Berridge. Funding was raised

through local sponsors; UHS vice-principal Reid Wilshire helped by obtaining a loan from the school.

"This project is definitely leading me into the technology field," said 19-year-old OAC student Amit Arora. "It has showed me how to apply what I've learned in school to real-life situations."

Part of the FIRST team created a website, video, 3-D animation and documentation to promote FIRST and the team.

"The OAC students taught me web design techniques," said Grade 9 student Ruby Ho, 14. "I learned how to communicate better and develop team working skills."

After brainstorming, the team decided to construct a robot that moved the Zone Zeal nets in

order to accumulate more points, explained Mr. Berridge. "We had the right design idea all along," he said as the robots in the finals used this strategy.

Four robots start on at each corner of a rectangular field. The object is to obtain the most points by placing balls in the net, dragging the net to the scoring zone and returning the robot to the starting point. Teams with the most points advance.

The competition was held at Mississauga's Hershey Centre, April 5 to 6, has teams from 650 Canadian, American and Brazilian schools.

"Winning the competition is not necessarily the prize," said Mr. Berridge. "The prize is uniting these schools to overcome an obstacle."

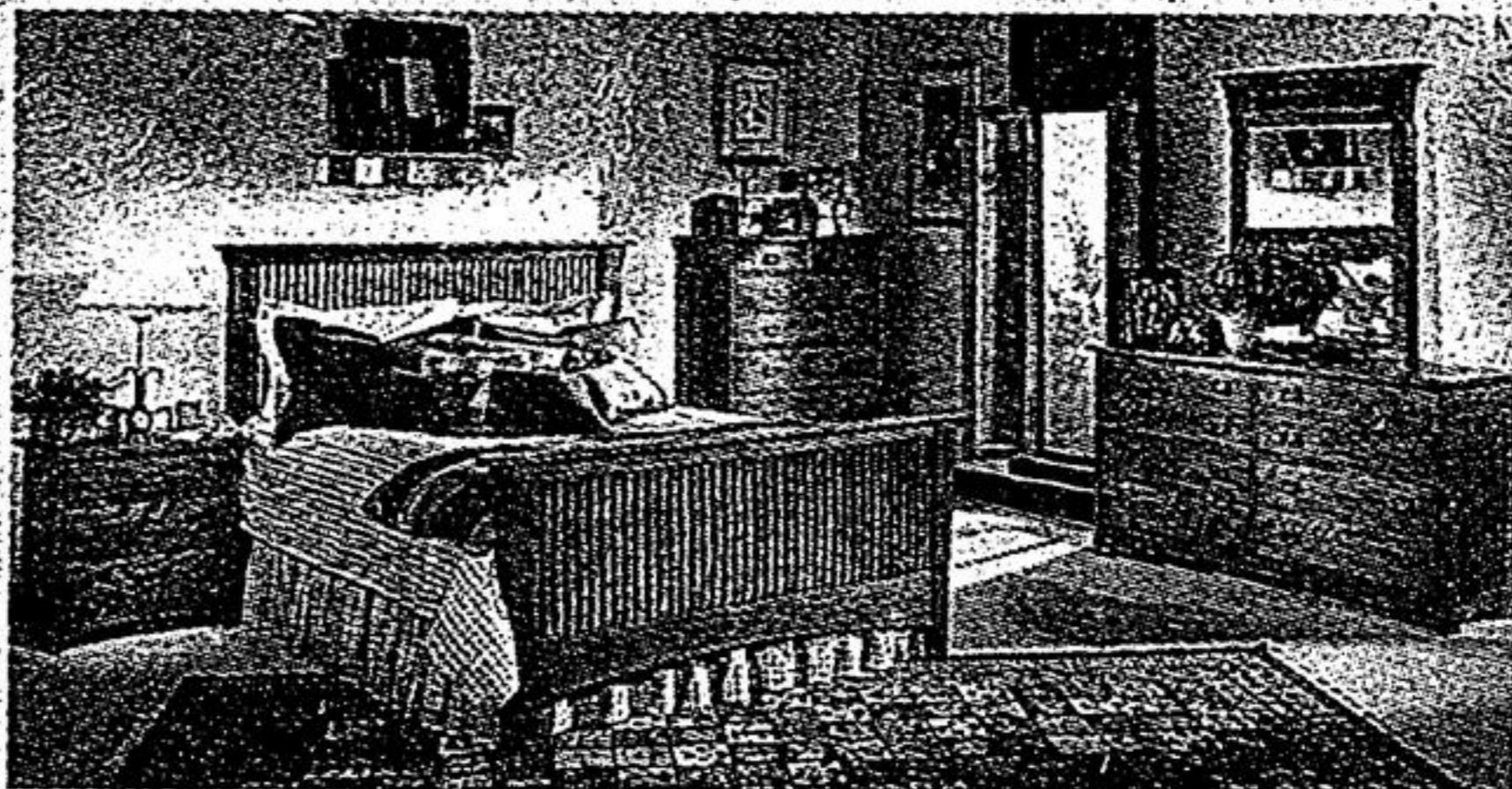
