recordings but also performed live.

"We are trying to track down a number of friends and associates, but that takes time. Hopefully those friends and associates will contact us."

Mr. Marson was six-foot tall and weighed 180 pounds. He lived with his father in Aurora and was single. Investigators do not have a motive or suspects in the homicide.

"As far as we can tell, robbery was not a motive," he said, adding Mr. Marson's identification was found with his body.

Homicide investigators and a forensic identification team combed the scene and the property around it Tuesday and Wednesday, seeking the murder weapon and other clues. The gun

which killed Mr. Marson has not been found.

The grisly discovery shocked residents.

"It's shocking," neighbour Erol Hasan, 40, told reporters.

The Whitchurch-Stouffville councillor for the area, Mark Carroll, said while residents are upset and worried by the murder so close to home, the neighbourhood remains safe.

"It's not a good thing for our neighborhood; it's quite a shock to find out about something like this," he said. "I hope nobody takes it to heart that it is that kind of community — it's not. It's still a safe community."
