the York Regional Police Drug Squad. If you have information about this incident or any other criminal offence call police or Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-TIPS."

York Regional Police drug unit Det. Mike Klimm said a man and woman were arrested in Peel Region Sunday night and officers seized more than 2,000 pounds of dried pot — worth about \$54,000 — as well as \$10,000 cash.

That arrest led investigators to the home at 19 Meyer Circle, where a joint task force including two officers from the Ontario Provincial Police, an Ontario Hydro representative and three York drug investigators seized a so-far undetermined number of plants.

An average of \$2,000 worth of electricity a month is used to run a typical grow lab, with operators using bypass

devices on the metres to avoid payment.

Det. Klimm said it was obvious the large lab was recently harvested, although two other crops were growing nearby.

Several bags of recently-used soil were piled in the garage, containing peat moss sacs used to start clone seeds growing before they are transplanted into pots.

Growers rarely use seeds anymore, preferring clones they can ensure are female plants which produce the potent buds.

"We are going to dismantle and disable the lab," Det. Klimm said, as neighbours looked on.

"This is unbelievable," said one man. "This is the fourth or fifth one in this neighbourhood."

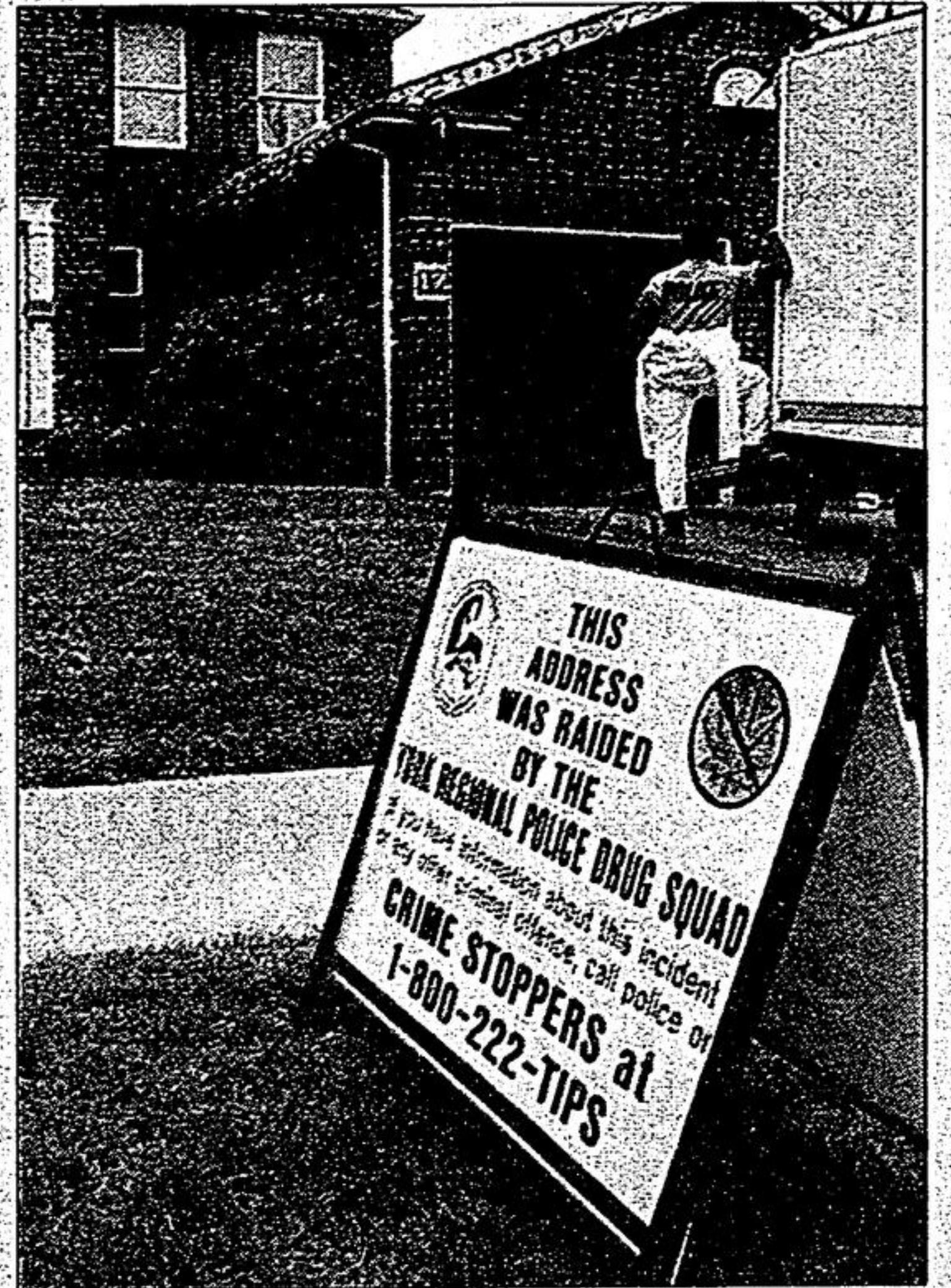
Another man complained about the half-dozen vehicles parked around the home.

Det. Klimm said if the pair arrested Sunday own the Markham home, it could be subject to seizure under the offence-related property or proceeds of crime sections in the Criminal Code.

He added the nine-year-old was staying with a friend's family.

A 27-year-old woman and a 28-year-old man face several drug related charges in Peel Region including producing a controlled substance, possession for the purpose of trafficking and theft of power.

They will likely face additional charges in York, still to be determined, Det. Klimm added.
