For the love of roses

What is our fascination with roses? After all, they are just one of thousands of gorgeous flowers whose blooms enchant us.

And yet there is something particularly seductive about roses. Over the centuries, we have used roses to express our deepest thoughts, declare our love and share out sadness. Even poets have gone to great lengths to describe our unique obsession with this special flower.

GROW ROSES YOURSELF!

Instead of waiting to receive roses on the rare special occasions, why not surround your life with them and grow roses yourself? With the proper care, this flower can grow wonderfully in

our Canadian climate. Whether you have a more traditional garden where they will serve as the centre of interest, or a more natural garden filled with shrub roses, these flowers can make a great addition to any garden.

First, never plant them close to sidewalks, doors or walkways where their thorns can scratch passersby, particularly young children whose eyes are at a very dangerous level. Also, if you have a small garden, avoid planting only roses because it will seem barren during the winter months. Instead, combine roses with evergreens and you will have something pleasant to look at all year long. For a bit of variety, both perennials and annuals work beautifully with roses.

NEVER CUT STEMS

If you plan to create bouquets of freshly cut roses to enjoy indoors, never cut stems from climbing roses growing on trellises or pergolas because this will quickly deplete the plant. Instead, plant a flowerbed in a secluded part of your garden where you can freely cut roses with a shearing knife. Finally, remember to cut roses early in the morning or late in the afternoon - never when the sun is at its peak.



Roses are well suited to our Canadian climate. For best results, there are certain rules you should follow when cultivating roses.

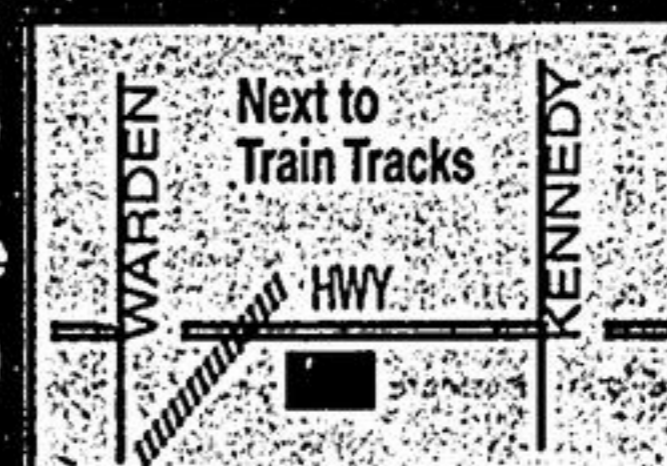
