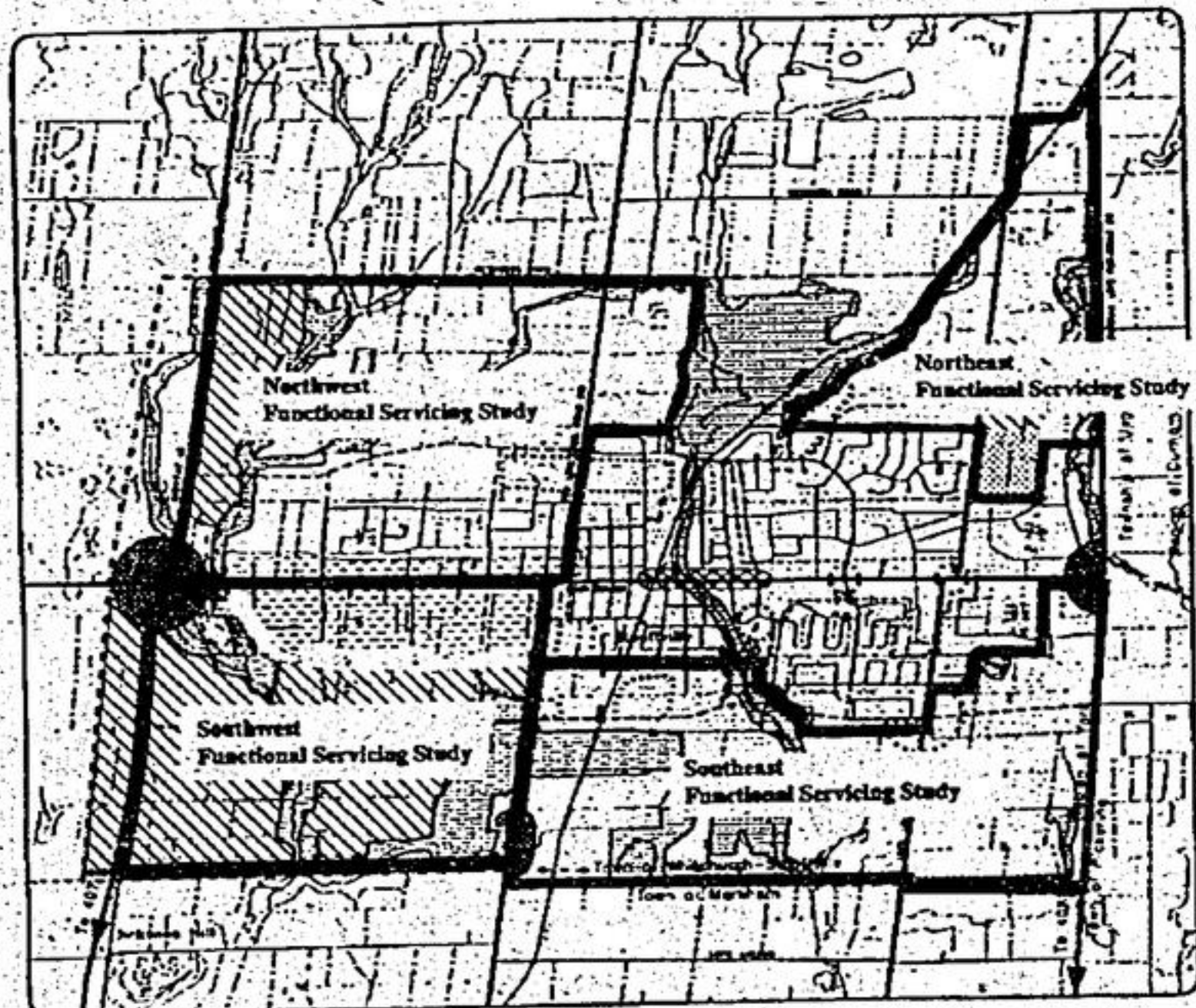

Functional Servicing Studies:

Development landowners in the Northeast, Southeast, Southwest & Northwest Quadrants of the Community of Stouffville have commissioned the preparation of studies to provide a comprehensive assessment of the limits and opportunities to development within the urban expansion areas of Stouffville. These studies have been completed consistent with the vision and guiding principles as set out in the Secondary Plan. Two focal points of analysis have been completed which identify and establish parameters to protect key environmental features from the impact of development, and, which demonstrates a range of land use activities that can be completed in a co-ordinated fashion as development occurs within the Community of Stouffville over the next 20 year period. Specific recommendations have also been developed to

ensure the timely completion and the co-ordination of the local & collector road system, trunk mains for sanitary, water and stormwater, preferred locations for area storm detention facilities, park facilities & open space system, and, school sites. Once approved, the Functional Servicing Studies will be used by the Town and other public agencies to assess site specific subdivision and development applications for the lands that have been designated for residential or employment uses as set out in the Stouffville Secondary Plan.

Open House / Public Meeting:

An **Open House** will be held on **Tuesday May 21st, 2002 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.** in the Council Chambers, Town Municipal Office, 37 Sandiford Drive, 4th Floor, Stouffville. The Open House will provide the opportunity for interested members of the community to meet in an informal setting with Municipal Staff and consultants to review & discuss the "draft" Functional Servicing Studies.

Following the Open House, Town Council will convene a **Public Meeting** on the "draft" Functional Servicing Studies, commencing at **7:00 p.m. on Tuesday May 21st, 2002** in the Council Chambers, Town Municipal Office, 37 Sandiford Drive, 4th Floor, Stouffville. A formal presentation on each of the four "draft" Functional Servicing Studies will be made. Questions on the four identified studies by interested members of the public will be received by Council as part of the Public Meeting process.

COMMUNITIES OF BALLANTRAE AND MUSSELMAN LAKE

The Public Works Department reminds residents that it is conducting routine flushing operations of the Ballantrae/Musselman Lake municipal water distribution system.

The next flushing of the system is scheduled to resume the week of May 27th, 2002 and will be conducted between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:30 pm and repeated every three (3) weeks.

This flushing is necessary to simulate normal operation of the system.

During the flushing operation discolouration of the water may occur and because of this we ask for your assistance by restricting the use of water to a minimum while the work is being conducted. Should discolouration of the water occur after the work has been completed let water run until it clears. Questions and concerns regarding this operation should be directed to the Public Works Department.

Penalty will be charged and added to your tax account at our office on payments made at the bank after the due dates. After hours tax payments may be made in the drop box at the front west entrance door of the Imperial Building (37 Sandiford Drive).

THE PENALTY charged for non-payment of 2002 taxes is one and one-quarter (1 1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.
