

Boyson earns heritage leadership honour

Markham student Laura Boyson has been recognized as a Young Heritage Leader by the provincial government and was congratulated at council recently.

Ms Boyson was one of 440 young people in 35 communities across Ontario to be honoured for contributions to cultural, natural or built heritage.

Mayor Don Cousens told Ms Boyson he was pleased to see young people participating in the protection of Markham's heritage.

"We don't have anything unless we remember the past," he said.

Ms Boyson's former teacher Diane More nominated her for the award, citing her commitment to save the historical train station on Markham Main Street.

"She addressed council and convinced them to take on the project," said

Ms More. "She was involved in the fundraising and the festivities, even dressing in period costume to open the station on its 130-year anniversary."

Sewer builder gives cash for Markhaven renovation

The Markhaven Foundation, raising money for the \$10 million renovation of the seniors' residence, accepted a \$5,000 cheque from McNally International at a recent council meeting.

McNally is the company building the Ninth Line trunk sewer, which has reached 16th Avenue, said vice-president Murray Malott.

"We are aware of the community's needs and the public inconvenience resulting from the project and we wanted to give something back to the community," Mr. Malott said.

Foundation president Harry James

accepted the cheque, saying without the support of community-minded corporations, the new Markhaven would not have had its April 26 groundbreaking.

Successful seniors centre paying off operating costs

The Older Adults in Action, responsible for the numerous seniors' programs run out of the Water Street Seniors Centre, presented a \$16,000 cheque to

council to be applied against operating costs.

Treasurer Betty Hoover handed over the fundraising dollars, used to pay for space at the seniors' complex.

"Our membership was projected to be about 300 by now — we're at 1,000," added president John Milligan.

Mayor Don Cousens pointed out the success of the Water Street programs is being duplicated in Milliken Mills, with more than 70 seniors participating in that community's new activity group.

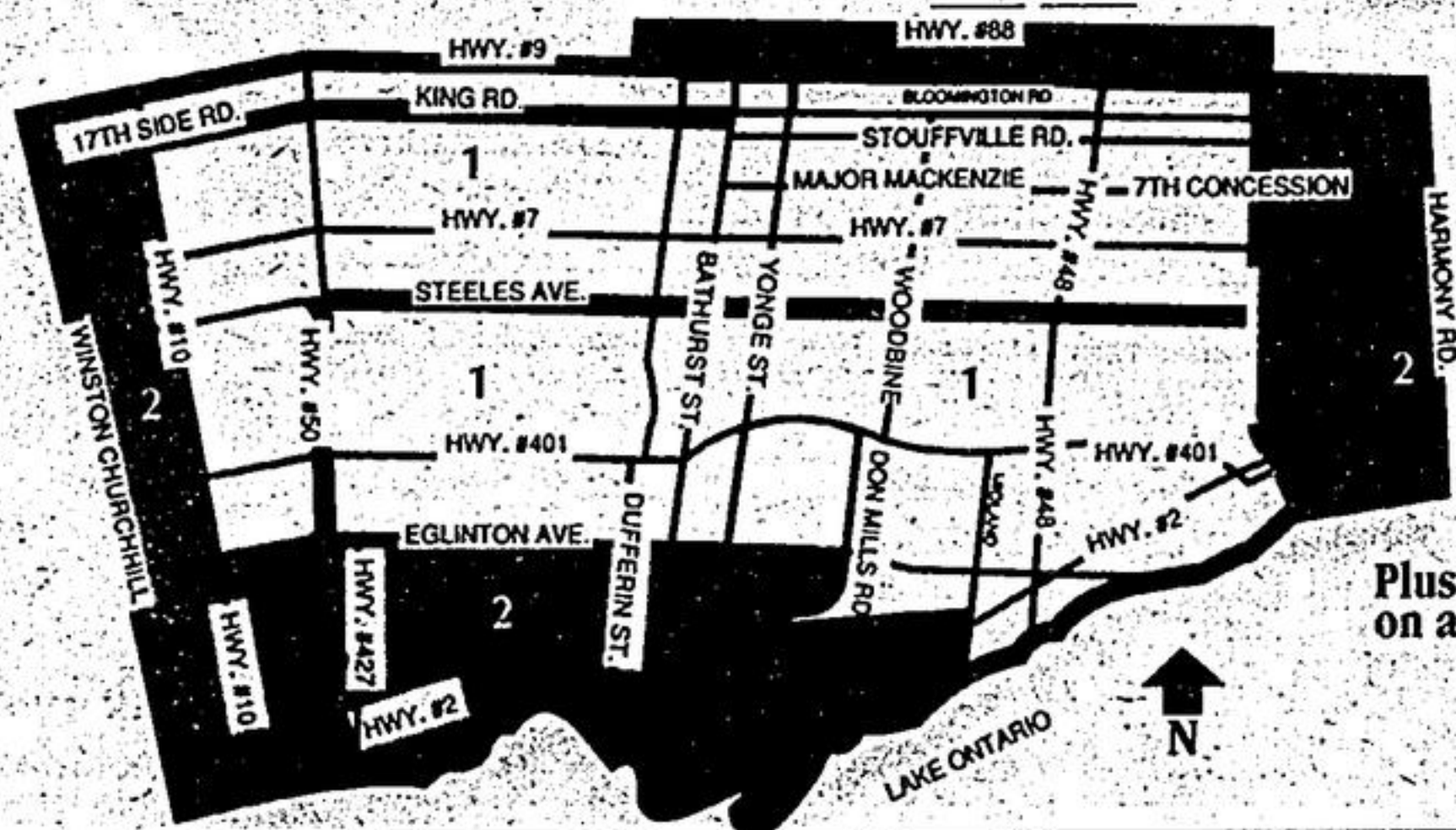
