the eventual roles to be played by the private sector and municipal partners, remains undetermined, according to Bryan Pennington, vice-president of Delcan, one of the companies involved in the successful consortium.

"The exact details of responsibility have not been finalized yet," he said, about 30 minutes after learning his group's bid had been declared the winner.

"This is the first (arrangement) of its kind in Canada."

He acknowledged, however, his consortium is comprised of a variety of players, including planners, builders,

financiers and transit operators, that could see the project through from the drawing board to daily operations.

"It is a full private-public partnership," Mr. Pennington said.

Mr. Fisch agreed York Consortium 2002 represents "an impressive list of firms".

He said the private sector partners will have to put up a substantial financial investment.

The winning bidders beat out some heavy hitters to land the deal with York Region. The unsuccessful candidates included companies such as Bombardier; Hydro One, Tyco Capital, Marshall Macklin Monaghan and SNC-Lavalin Engineers & Constructors Inc.
