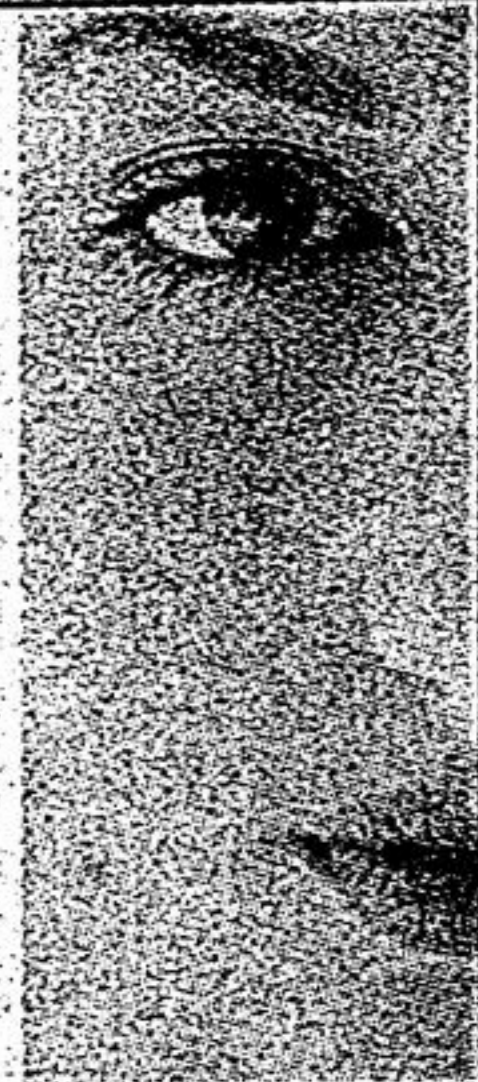

## Spring Floor Model Sale and Paint Café seminars planned for The Queen's Pantry
