

Angus Glen owner has big plans for new Quebec course

and training centre are slated to be ready for play in June, 2005. Angus Glen Golf Club is slated to host the Bell Canadian Open this September on its original south course and in 2007 on the newer north course.

Gordon Stollery's interest in the game of golf is clear.

He followed through on his father's vision, by creating the Angus Glen Golf Club in Unionville in 1995 and opening another 18-hole course at the Kennedy Road club last year.

But Mr. Stollery, who is a co-owner of Angus Glen, and is also involved in the purebred cattle business through his Angus Glen Farm in Unionville, hasn't finished playing a full round of golf just yet. He lives on the seventh hole of the course.

On Friday, a press conference was held in Montreal to announce that Mr. Stollery was part of a private partnership group along with Michael Columbos of Calgary which will work in conjunction with the Royal Canadian Golf Association to develop a \$40-million golf course facility in the city of Terrebonne, a 30-minute drive from Montreal.

The group, called CCQ, will develop and operate two 18-hole championship golf courses on a 1,000-acre parcel of land. The RCGA, meanwhile, plans to construct and operate a 120-acre national training centre on the property.

With the creation of this facility, the RCGA has committed to bring the Bell Canadian Open to the CCQ courses five times over a 20-year period. The first Open is tentatively scheduled to be played there in 2006.

The RCGA will bring four national amateur championships to these courses over the same 20-year period.

Construction is expected to commence in June, 2003 and the courses

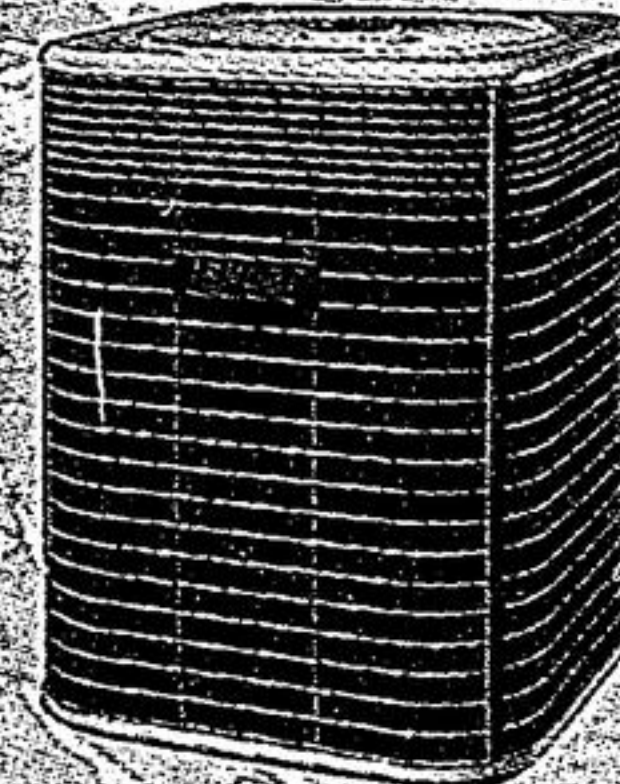
