

Suspect sought in Daisy Mart hold-up

Police are hunting a young suspect after a 70-year-old clerk was robbed at gunpoint last Friday night.

The 20-something man entered the Daisy Mart on Kennedy Road, south of 14th Avenue about 10 p.m.

He pointed a gun at the elderly man behind the counter and demanded cash.

The clerk handed over an undisclosed amount of cash

and the man fled on foot. His face was covered, but he wore glasses, a hat and dark clothing.

Detectives are trying to track down more than \$7,000 worth of antique jewelry stolen in a residential break-and-enter in Markham last Thursday afternoon.

Missing from the John Dexter Place home, in the Hwy. 7 and Wooten Way area, are a pearl cluster brooch, a gold necklace with a heart-shaped pearl pendant, a double-stranded pearl necklace, and a gold, four-diamond ring, among other items.

The jewelry is estimated to be worth \$7,250.
