Nick Dambrosio led the way, scoring twice and driving in three runs. Humphries also drove in three runs with a double and a sacrifice fly.

Dalgarno was the winning pitcher.

With two wins and a loss, Stouffville qualified for the championship final.

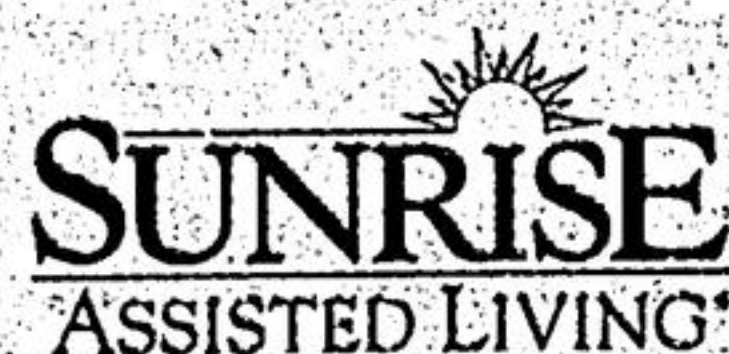
