NOTICE TO RESIDENTS REGARDING GARBAGE & RECYCLING COLLECTION

It is anticipated that the garbage and recycling collection in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will not be affected by the strike of members of Local 416 of the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) in the City of Toronto.

Collection will be completed as scheduled, however, the collection contractor (Miller Waste Systems) may experience delays at the landfills which could result in a later than normal pick-up time.

The public drop-off facility and household hazardous waste depot at the Keele Valley Landfill **will be closed** for the duration of the strike. The hazardous waste depots in East Gwillimbury and Markham and the Georgina Transfer Station will be open.

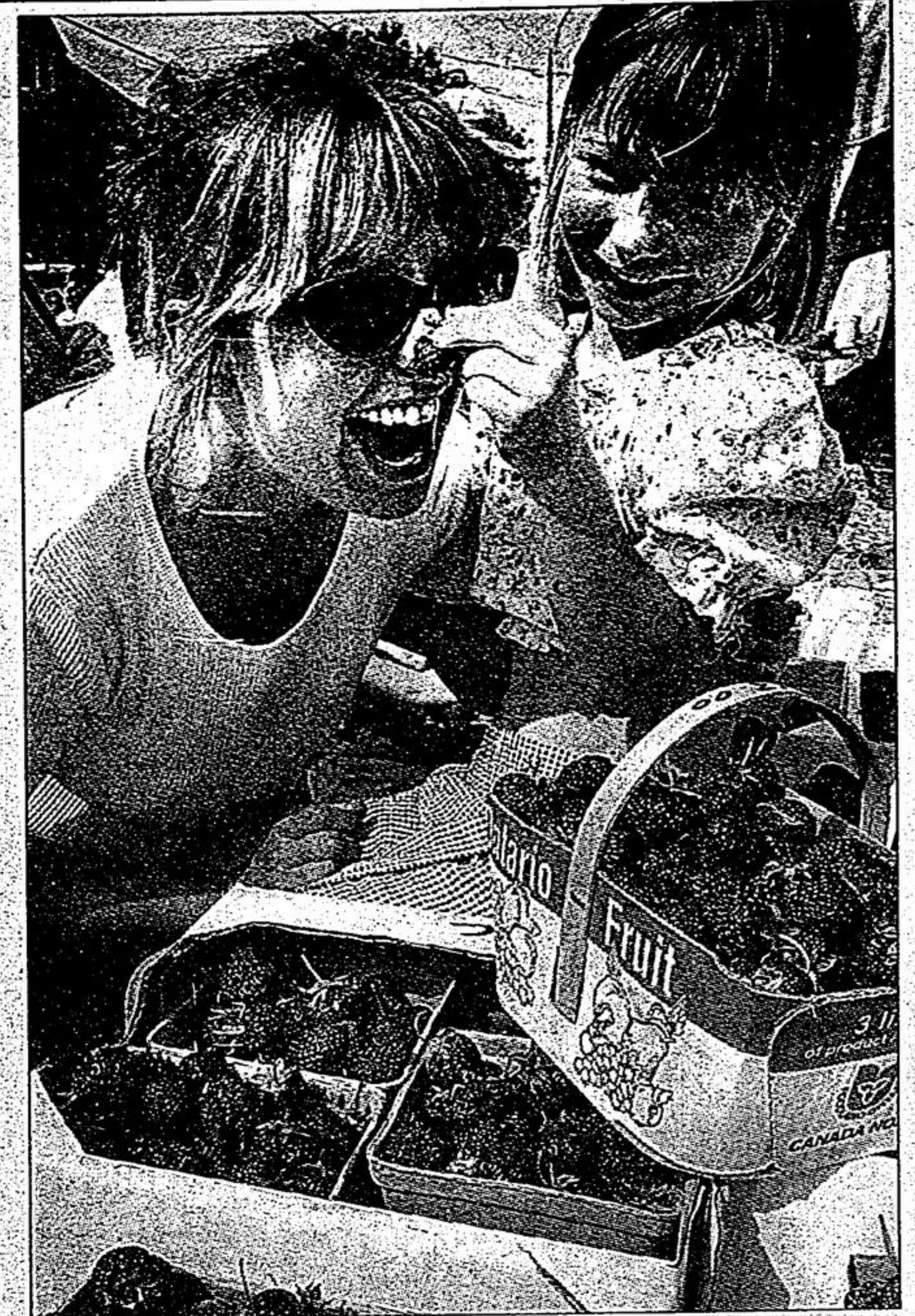

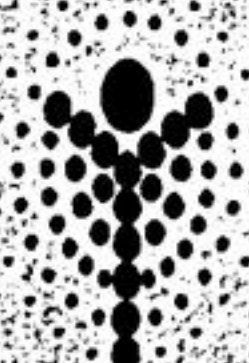
