IN THE MATTER OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER O.18 AND IN THE MATTER OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES AT THE FOLLOWING MUNICIPAL ADDRESS(ES) IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville intends to designate the property (properties), including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address(es) as a property (properties) of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18.

- (a) **6060 Main Street, Stouffville**
Reasons for designation:
6060 Main Street is to be designated for its historical and architectural value. Built for Nelson Patterson in 1885, the house is one of the oldest buildings in Stouffville. A veterinarian, Patterson operated an office and surgery from the property. His business was an important part of the local agrarian community. The house is significant for its Victorian architecture including the exterior decorative woodwork, arched windows, plaster cornice mouldings, etched glass pocket dining room doors, and L-shaped stairwell with decorative frieze. The building is also important because of its prominent location on the town's historic Main Street.

Any person may, within thirty days of the publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville shall refer the matter to the Heritage Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
