Three surgeries for girl who lost toes

Little Rebecca Ramer continues to recover from a tragic lawnmower accident last week with the help and support of the Markham and Stouffville communities.

Her dad, Paul Ramer, said Wednesday four-year-old Rebecca has undergone three surgeries, but continues to improve.

"She had her third surgery on Monday and doctors found a small amount of infection, but it's almost cleared up and they're not too concerned," he said. "They were going to close the wound then, but they're going to leave it until the infection is gone. They keep flushing the wound and she should be off antibiotics soon."

Rebecca lost five toes and the ball of her right foot last Thursday after her mom Jane, on a riding lawnmower, backed up not realizing Rebecca was behind her.

The tot was airlifted to the Hospital for Sick Children from Markham Stouffville Hospital after the 2:30 p.m. accident at the family's Reesor Road farm.

Rebecca begins the first of what's sure to be many physical therapy sessions this week.

"She hasn't been out of bed much and they want her moving," Mr. Ramer said, adding Rebecca has been transferred to a bed in the burn unit so doctors can perform the first skin grafts on her leg which was cut badly.

"She's not real keen about that," Mr. Ramer said.

But she's holding up. And the Markham and Whitchurch-Stouffville community is rallying around the family.

A family friend bought Rebecca a Gameboy to help her pass the time.

Another friend has set up a trust fund to help defray travelling and other expenses as Rebecca recovers. She's expected to be in hospital about a month. The account is with TD Canada Trust, branch number 3700 and the account number is 6210743.

The Shriners have already contacted the family offering their substantial support — an assessment at a Montreal hospital once Rebecca is released from Sick Kids and the cost of a prosthesis and special shoes until she turns 18.
