APPOINTMENT TO THE WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

On September 30th, 2002, the Province will proclaim the Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2001. This new legislation is designed to improve independence and opportunities for persons with disabilities and to provide for their involvement in the identification, removal and prevention of barriers. As a result, the Town is establishing an Accessibility Advisory Committee whose role would be to promote equal opportunity and access for all persons, regardless of needs.

In order to more fully identify existing barriers, at least fifty percent of the Committee must be comprised of people with disabilities and should reflect the diversity of concerns from various people with disabilities.

The Committee would meet monthly or more or less frequently as required.

Application forms may be obtained from Clerk's Department, the Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library or the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum during office hours.

Completed applications should be returned to the Clerk's Department either in person or by mail **no later than 4:30 p.m., Monday, September 23rd, 2002.** No applications, whether received by mail or hand delivered, can be accepted after the deadline.
