

Transit-loving boy found by police near airport

A nine-year-old boy Markham boy who took a six-hour joy ride on public transit was returned to his family safe and sound early Tuesday morning.

Barrington Harrison was picked up as he left a TTC bus near the International Centre on Airport Road after 2 a.m.

His family had reported him missing about 8:15 Monday night and told police the boy likes taking long bus rides.

A Greater Toronto Area-wide alert was issued and the media was asked to alert the public to watch for him.

About 9:30 p.m., TTC officials notified York Regional Police that security

tapes revealed the boy had boarded a downtown train.

It's not the first time Barrington has taken off using public transit; the last time he was located at Finch subway station, said Det. Mike Young.

Peel Regional Police spotted Barrington as he left the bus in Malton and brought him home unharmed.

Sgt. Tony Browne extended thanks to the public for helping locate the boy.

Dispute ends with charges

An dispute over who was at fault in a collision in the parking lot of Milliken's Pacific Mall landed a Richmond Hill man in hospital suffering head injuries.

Police said two men, 28 and 29, from

Scarborough, were in a van which collided with the victim's beige Honda about 10:45 a.m. Wednesday.

After an argument over who was at fault, the 38-year-old victim was hit in the head repeatedly with wooden sticks, said Const. Kolin Alexander.

"The victim suffered non-life-threatening injuries, but was taken to Markham Stouffville Hospital for treatment," he said.

The two suspects fled the scene, but witnesses were able to provide a description of the van and a plate number. Police made an arrest a short time later.

Two men are charged with one count each of assault with a weapon.
