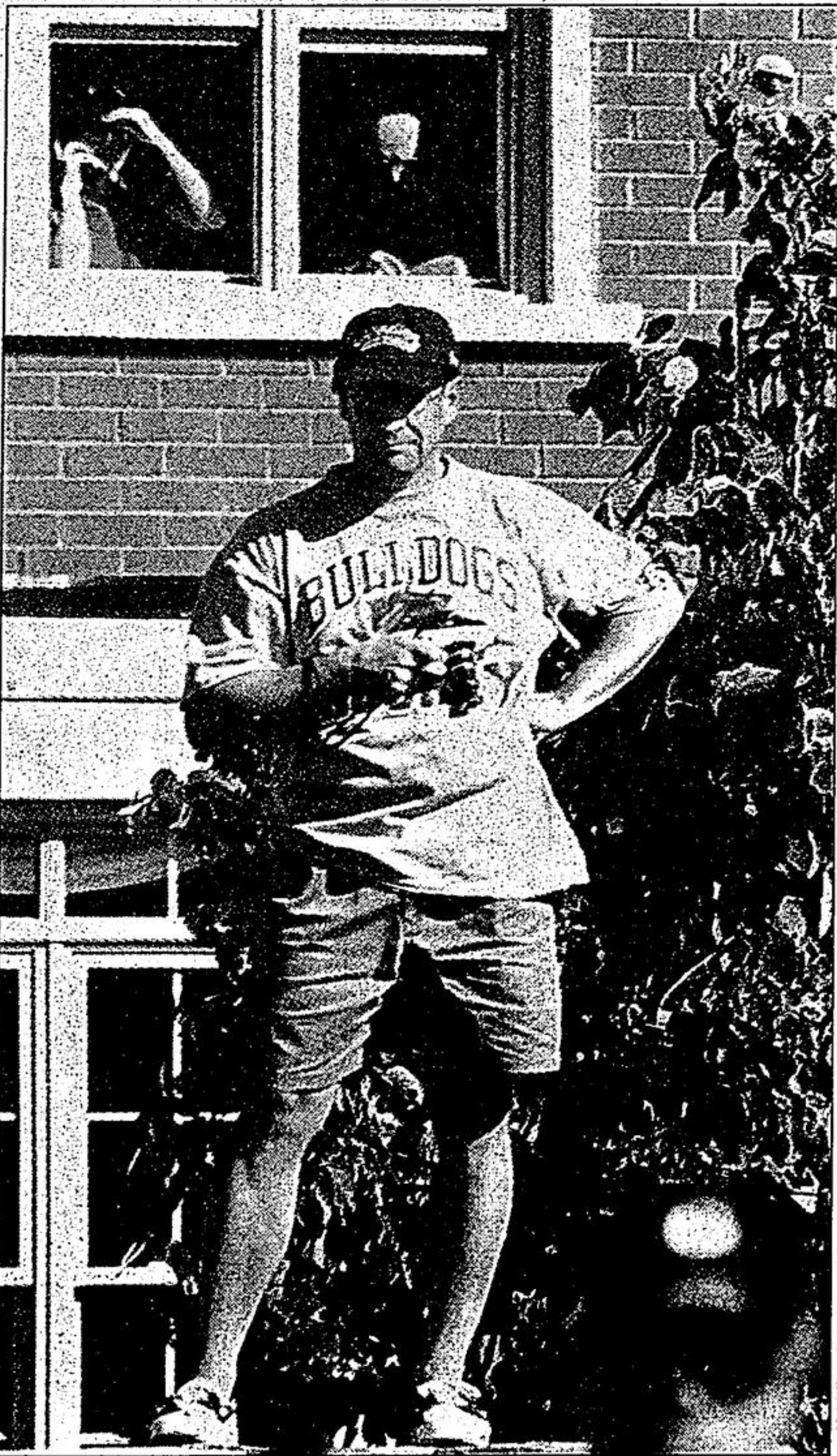


On the prowl for players at the Open
