# Doctors, MPP on panel at York Region health care forum

The province is spending nearly half its budget on health care, yet thousands of patients can't get in to see a doctor.

The problem is even worse in rural areas, including many communities in York Region.

York's health care services are chronically underfunded, meaning residents must either seek care outside the region or face long waiting lists.

These are just a few of the issues that will be addressed

when the York Region Newspaper Group hosts a health forum next Tuesday night.

The event will feature seven panel members, including Oak Ridges MPP Frank Klees, York Region Medical Officer of Health Dr. Helena Jaczek, York Central Hospital chief of family practice Dr. Ian Zatzman and patient advocate Peter Hamilton.

The forum will feature panel members addressing concerns and offering solutions to the

problems facing our overstressed health care system.

The audience will also be invited to ask questions after the debate.


The forum, which will begin at 7:30 p.m., will be held at the Newmarket Theatre on Mulock Drive between Leslie Street and College Manor Drive.

They are midsize and less crowded compared to the larger centres. On the other hand, Air Zone has more play value compared to a private centre. I was also pleased


