PUBLIC NOTICE

YARD WASTE/LEAF COLLECTION

Residents are advised that starting this fall, leaves will only be collected if they are in clear plastic bags, paper bags or reusable open top containers (excluding cardboard boxes) such as bushel baskets or garbage cans.

The Town will no longer be picking up leaves raked, blown or piled along the roads.

Non-containerized or non-bagged leaves present a traffic and drainage hazard and residents are required to remove them.

REALTY TAXES

THE FINAL INSTALMENT OF REALTY TAXES IS DUE OCTOBER 18TH, 2002

AND

2002 FINAL COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL & MULTI-RESIDENTIAL TAX BILLS

1st Instalment Due - October 18, 2002

2nd Instalment Due - November 15, 2002

COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL & MULTI-RESIDENTIAL TAX bills have now been mailed. Ratepayers who have not received their bills should make immediate application to the Municipal Tax Department.

THE PENALTY charged for non-payment of 2002 taxes is one and one-quarter (1 1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.

FAILURE TO receive a tax bill does not eliminate the responsibility for payment of taxes nor the penalty charges for late payment.

TAX PAYMENTS may be made by mail, or in person at the Town Office and at most Financial Institutions through tellers, banking machines and by telephone. Banking fees may apply. Penalty will be charged and added to your tax account at our office on payments made at the bank after the due dates. After hours tax payments may be left in the drop box at the front west entrance door of the Imperial Building (37 Sandiford Drive).

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RATEPAYERS OF THE TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE

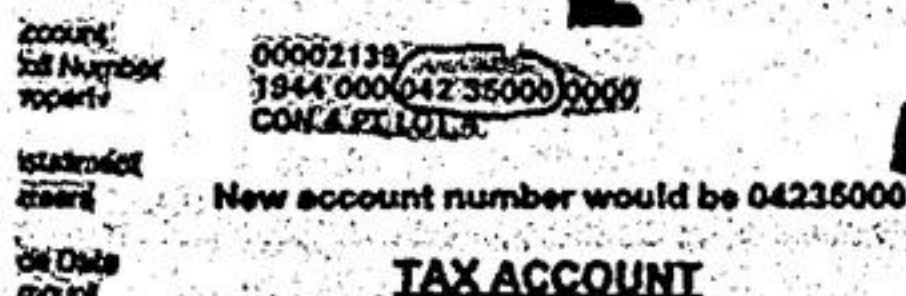

Effective October 1st, 2002 please adjust your account numbers as follows:

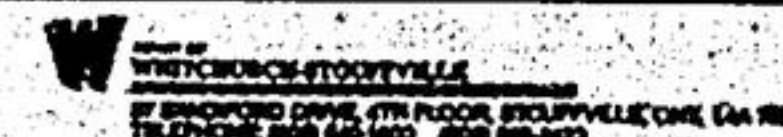
1. Tax account numbers will now change to the portion of the Tax Roll Number as indicated on the copy below.

2. For the Water accounts the alpha characters at the beginning of each account such as "W or M" will be deleted. The alpha characters at the end will be replaced as follows: A = 01, B = 02 and C = 03. The remaining digits/numbers will remain unchanged.

PROPOSED REGIONAL OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT 41
THE OAK RIDGES MORAINÉ CONSERVATION PLAN
AMENDMENT

On December 14, 2001, the Province of Ontario proclaimed the *Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Act*. Section 9 of this Act requires the Region of York to adopt an amendment to its Official Plan before April 22, 2003 to bring the Regional Official Plan into conformity with the Provincial Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan. Area municipalities in York are also required to bring their official plans and zoning by-laws into conformity with the ORMCP prior to October 22, 2003.

This Proposed Amendment is intended to bring the Regional Plan into conformity with the Provincial Plan as required by the *Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Act, 2001*.

The effect of this Amendment is to:

- identify the approved Provincial Oak Ridges Moraine Boundary and Area on Maps 2 through 10 of the ROP;
- identify the approved Provincial Oak Ridges Moraine Boundary and the Provincial land use designations within the Oak Ridges Moraine area on a new Map 11 to the ROP;
- provide policy direction in Section 2.5 of the Regional Official Plan for lands within the Moraine and provide cross-referencing in other sections of the Plan to the ORMCP policies.

The area of York covered by the Moraine Plan is shown below:



Public information sessions will be held to inform the public and receive comments on this proposed Amendment.
