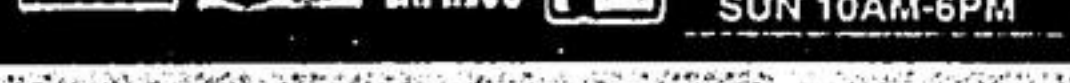

A public meeting will be held in accordance with Section 17(15) of the Planning Act, as amended May 22, 1996, to inform the public and receive comments on proposed Amendment 41 to the Official Plan for the Regional Municipality of York, File No. D05.102.61:

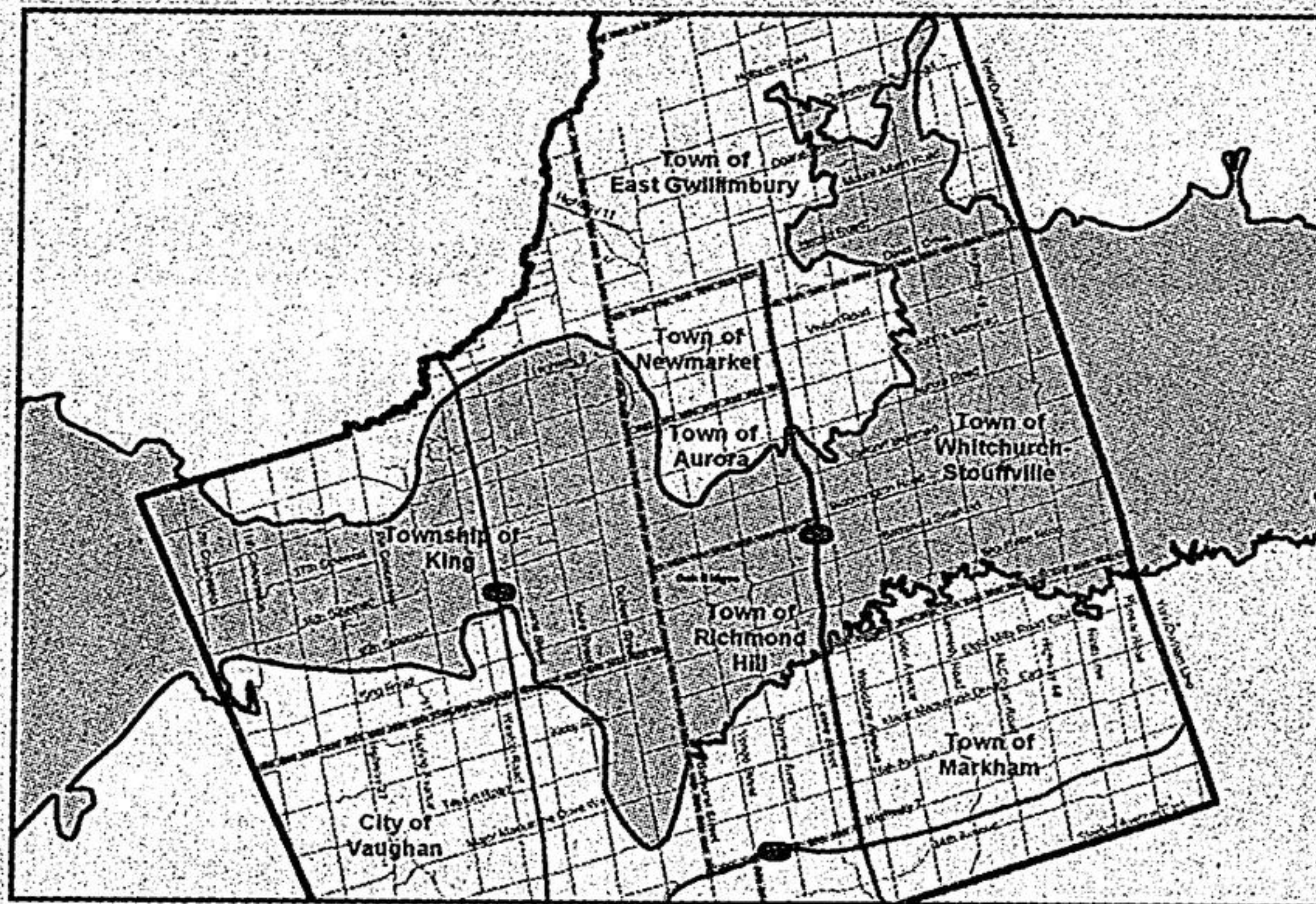

Purpose and effect of this Amendment:

On December 14, 2001, the Province of Ontario proclaimed the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Act, Section 9 of this Act requires the Region of York to adopt an amendment to its Official Plan before April 22, 2003 to bring the Regional Official Plan into conformity with the Provincial Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan. Area municipalities in York Region are required to bring their Official Plans and zoning by-laws into conformity with the ORMCP prior to October 22, 2003.

This proposed Amendment is intended to bring the Regional Plan into conformity with the Provincial Plan as required by the Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Act, 2001.

The effect of this Amendment is to identify the approved Provincial Oak Ridges Moraine Boundary, the Provincial land use designations within the Oak Ridges Moraine area and provide policy direction at the Regional level for lands within the Moraine in York Region. The area of York Region covered by the Moraine Plan is shown below:

A copy of the proposed Amendment as well as background information will be available for inspection at the York Region Planning and Development Services Department (see address and telephone numbers at the end of this notice) and Area Municipal Planning Departments from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on regular business days. A copy of the Amendment as well as all maps and background information is available for viewing or printing from the Region of York website: www.region.york.on.ca.

Approval process:

Following the public meeting, the Council of the Regional Municipality of York may, if it chooses, adopt the proposed Amendment, and give notice of the decision to adopt the Amendment.

Pursuant to Ontario Regulation 525/97, made under the Planning Act, amendments to the Official Plan for the Regional Municipality of York commenced on or after January 19, 1998, are exempt from the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing. Once notice of decision is given, if you have any objections to this amendment you may file with the Clerk of the Regional Municipality of York, within the time specified in the notice of decision, a notice of appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board.

NOTE:

1. If a person or public body that files a notice of appeal of a decision of The Regional Municipality of York in respect of the proposed Official Plan Amendment does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or does not make written submissions to The Regional Municipality of York before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.
2. If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan Amendment you must make a written request to the Clerk of The Regional Municipality of York, in care of the address of the York Region Administrative Centre, at the end of this notice.

Any person may attend the public meeting and/or make oral or written submissions either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Plan/Amendment.
