

Markham firm hopes to expand with new printing process

More jobs could be on the way as Markham company Labelad advances technologically.

The Cochrane Drive firm was recently selected by two of the largest names in graphic art production to launch a new printing process called Hexachrome, which works with six colours instead of the traditional four.

Labelad Inc. produces a variety of pressure sensitive labels and flexible packaging for such household brand names as Dove, Hellman's Mayonnaise, President's Choice,

Jergens, Mitchum Deodorant, Aveda, Degree Deodorant and Lactancia Cream Cheese.

Currently, the company employs about 500 people. It hopes to expand with the introduction of this technology.

Although the family-owned firm does an equal amount of business in Canada and the U.S., everything is made in Canada.

Labelad Inc. and its sister company Sandylion Sticker Designs sell their products in 64 countries.
