

Experts can help make homes enviro-friendly

Meetings in the region this month offer free advice on how to run a farm or a rural homestead without harming the environment.

Plenty of experts will be on hand Wednesday at the Ballantrae Community Centre to tell you how and why to try a conservation project on your land.

"There's funding for just about everything nowadays and expertise to help you do all these things," said Whitchurch-Stouffville Councillor Mark Carroll, organizer of the 3-9 p.m. event.

One agency that will be represented at the centre, on Aurora Road east of Hwy. 48, recently celebrated its 500th project with a private landowner.

Four years ago, the Ontario Wetland Habitat Fund contributed \$3,000, matched by another landowner, to expand a buffer around a wetland in King Township.

The owner then signed a 10-year agreement, not registered to title, to protect the wetland.

Ducks Unlimited Canada, York Region's forestry department, area conservation authorities and other groups will also be on hand.

Later this month, there's also an information night planned on soil and water conservation projects for farmers.

Experts will speak on financial incentives offered with these projects during the free workshop, 7-9 p.m. Nov. 28 at Boyd Field Centre on Canada Company Avenue, off Islington Avenue in Vaughan.

Toronto and Region Conservation

Toronto and Region Conservation (TRCA) has commenced a study regarding the dam in the Bruce's Mill Conservation Area located in Whitchurch-Stouffville in the headwaters of the Rouge River. This study is looking at the problems associated with the condition of the dam, the purpose of the dam, and the environmental impairments related to the dam regarding poor sediment transport, water temperature increases and the lack of coldwater fish movement through the dam.

TRCA invites you to participate in this study to determine how best to address these problems. The study will follow the planning and design process described in the Class Environmental Assessment for Remedial Flood and Erosion Control Projects (Conservation Ontario).
