Council lists youth problems, solutions

...what the mayor now calls a problem that's 'getting out of control.'

said Mayor Emmerson, a graduate of SDSS.

During Tuesday's discussion, councillors cited a host of problems including:

- Excessive littering and loitering along Edward Street and the surrounding area, including downtown.
- Littering problems linked to fast food restaurants.
- A double amputee having his motorized scooter stolen and then thrown in a creek.
- The seat on the Main St. gazebo being smashed.
- Playground equipment being torched

at a parkette on Bramble Crescent.

- Police arresting 17 teens on drug and assault charges.
- Teens roaming the streets late at night
- A 16-year-old robbed of his camera behind Summitview Public School.
- A 15-year old jumped and beaten by three youths on the Tenth Line.
- Students smoking in view of the SDSS' principal's office.
- SDSS teachers smoking along side students on Edward Street.
- SDSS being in a deplorable state with broken chairs and kicked in lockers.

During the discussion, Mayor Emmerson and the councillors came up with a number of ideas to address what the mayor now calls a problem that's "getting out of control." Suggestions include:

- Having SDSS set up a student environmental committee to help address the littering problem on Edward Street.
- Encouraging SDSS officials and police to enforce laws linked to smoking tobacco.
- Inviting SDSS students to police themselves on Edward Street.
- Having Mayor Emmerson address the students on SDSS' PA system about the littering off school property.
- Striking a delegation to respond to the community-wide youth problems.
- Fingerprinting the garbage as a way to help identify the litter bugs.
- Placing more garbage containers on town streets.
- Teaching students how to take three or four steps to put their garbage in a container.
- Increasing police presence in town.
- Asking fast food restaurants to accept more responsibility for their garbage.

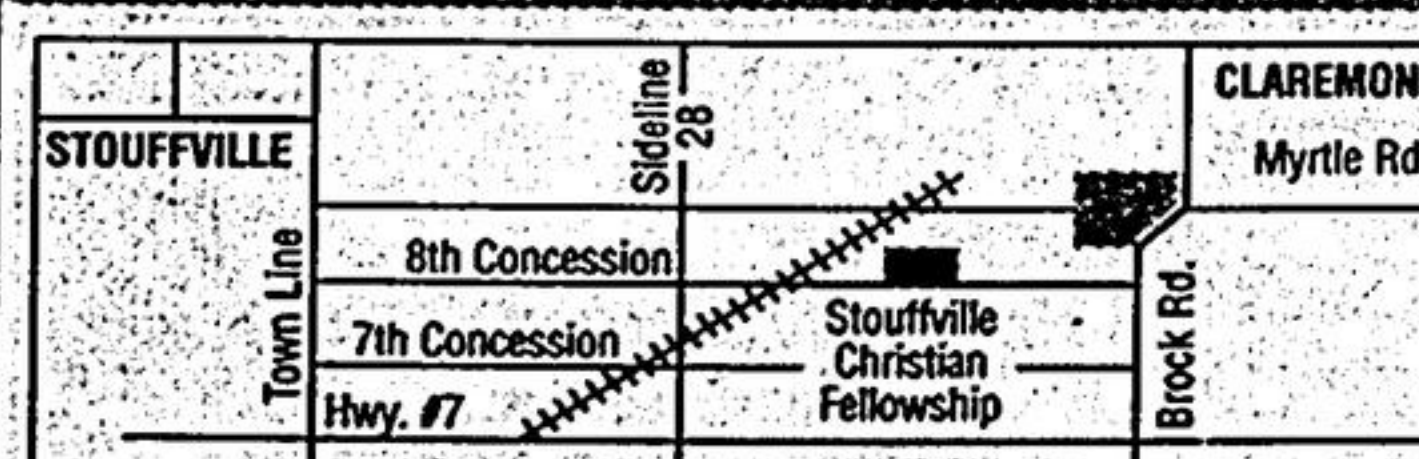
The Stouffville Christian Fellowship Free Counselling Seminar

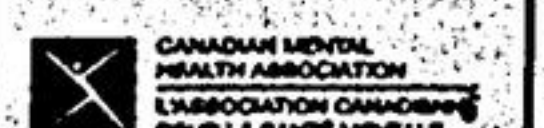
