Stouffville's Neighbourhood Employment Resource Centre is now serving more residents, offering more workshops and recently went online as part of Stouffville's business-to-business website, stouffville.biz.

Since NERC moved to its new quarters at 28 Sandiford Dr. in October, "the number of people we have been able to serve has at least doubled," said employment facilitator Gail Simpson.

Through its stouffville.biz website, the NERC is able to give local small businesses and individuals up-to-date information on workshops and seminars such as those on assertiveness training, conflict management, resume writing, business networking and internet training.

More of the workshops are being offered in the evening, noted Ms Simpson, so more people are able to attend.

New partners coming onto the stouffville.biz site benefit all members, noted Claudiu Popa, one of the website's co-founders.

Many of the businesses new to the site are offering special services or discounts to fellow business people in town. Membership in stouffville.biz is free to all local businesses and professionals until May 1, 2003.


A two-week course for women who have been out of the workforce for some time is being held at NERC from March 24 to April 4.




WE MAY BE VISITING YOU BETWEEN MARCH 1 & MARCH 9
