Please call to make arrangements **no later** than 4:00 pm the Friday preceding your area's regular scheduled large article collection. Please refer to the 2003 Garbage & Recycling Schedule for collection dates in your area.

### RECYCLING COLLECTION

- WAXED PAPER/CARDBOARD
- GIFT WRAP
- PLASTIC WRAP
- FROZEN FOOD BOXES (WITH WAXED OR GLOSSY COATING)
- HAZARDOUS WASTE
- LIGHT BULBS, CERAMICS OR CRYSTAL
- PLASTIC WHITE TROPICANA ORANGE JUICE CONTAINERS MARKED ON THE BOTTOM COMPATIBLE WITH #2 SYMBOL
