Vandorf W.I., 96, and going strong

The Vandorf Women's Institute recently presented a book on the history of women's institutes to the Whitchurch-Stouffville Museum.

Women's institutes were started by Canadian Adelaide Hoodless close to a century ago to give rural and stay-at-home women a forum to exchange ideas, learn from each other and socialize.

The Vandorf Women's

Institute held its first meeting in 1907 and is still going strong with 18 members.

Speakers are invited to many of the group's monthly meetings to talk on everything from agricultural to international matters. Community outreach programs include providing gift baskets and necessities to needy families at Christmas and to shut-ins.

The Vandorf Women's Institute meets the fourth Wednesday of every month at 1:30 p.m. in members' homes and other locations.

Over the years, women's institutes lobbied for far-reaching initiatives such as having milk pasteurized, selling bread wrapped and stopping traffic both ways for school buses.

In the early days, the Women's Institute gave women a place to get together "to socialize and learn what they needed to know when they were on the farm," noted Vandorf Women's Institute member Bertha Pattenden.
