Bush's God talk rings hollow

should be in a bar in Texas, not the Oval Office. There is only one reason that I am in the Oval Office and not in a bar: I found faith. I found God."

Speaking at the Yale commencement in 2001, President Bush suggested God found him. "When I left here, I didn't have much in the way of a life plan," he said. "I knew some people who thought they did. But it turned out that we were all in for ups and downs ... Life takes its own turns, makes its own demands, writes its own story. And, along the way, we start to realize we are not the author."

It's interesting to note how President Bush came to religion. It was less out of a sense of true spiritual conviction than a need to steel himself for his main challenge in life to that point: to quit drinking.

President Bush says he never considered himself an alcoholic and never attended an AA meeting. But it turned out he didn't have to, relying instead on a program called Community Bible Study, described in a recent Newsweek cover story as a scriptural boot camp, an intensive, year-long study of a single book of the New Testament, each week a new chapter, with detailed reading and discussion

in a group of 10 men. It worked. As the world knows, President Bush quit drinking after his 40th birthday.

That's why President Bush's God talk rings hollow. His faith seems undisciplined and convenient because it came out of a self-help group. Jesus is his comforter, one who makes alcoholics feel good, as opposed to someone who has demands.

And the "moral clarity" President Bush's apologists (Mr. Frum included) salute him for scares me, for it accords the president fearful powers. After all, when you're fighting evil, all means are not only permissible, they are sanctified.

The next phase in President Bush's spiritual development will come only when he understands the words of "another occupant of his office. Abraham Lincoln once said not so much God was on our side, but, rather, we need to make sure we're on God's side."

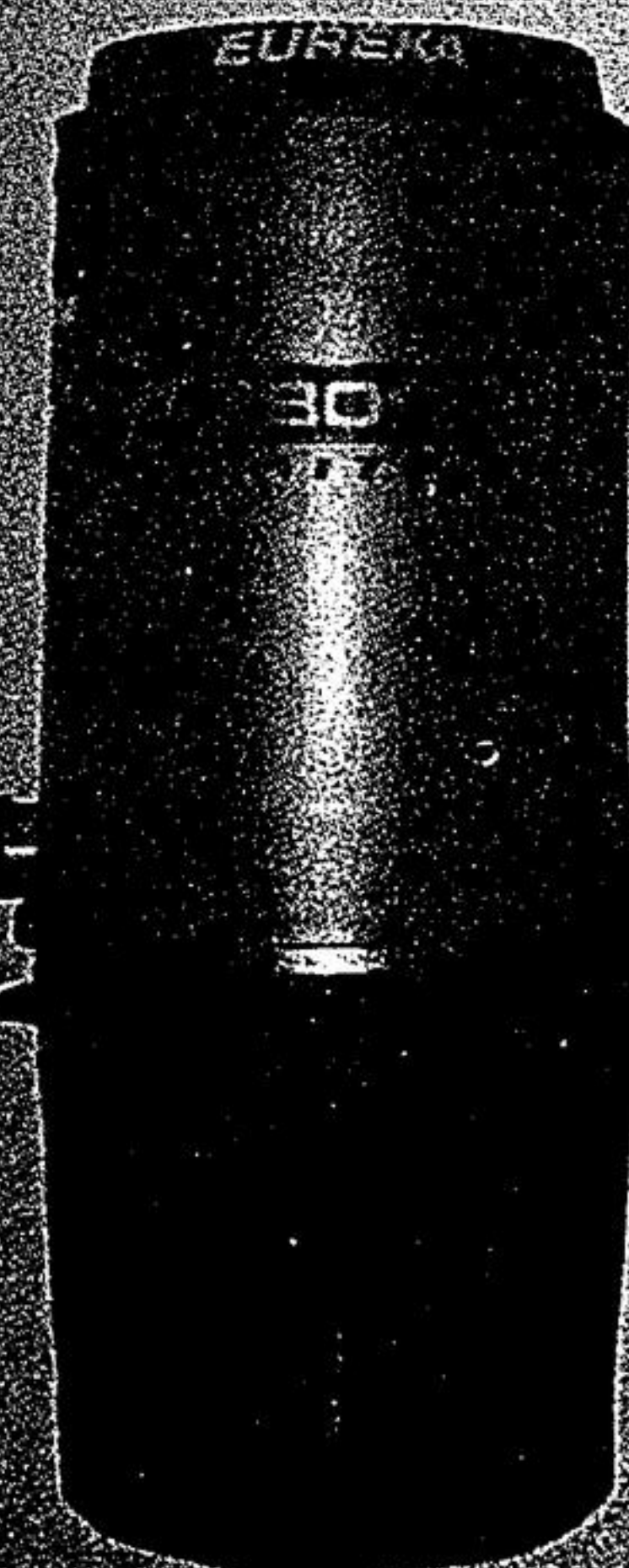

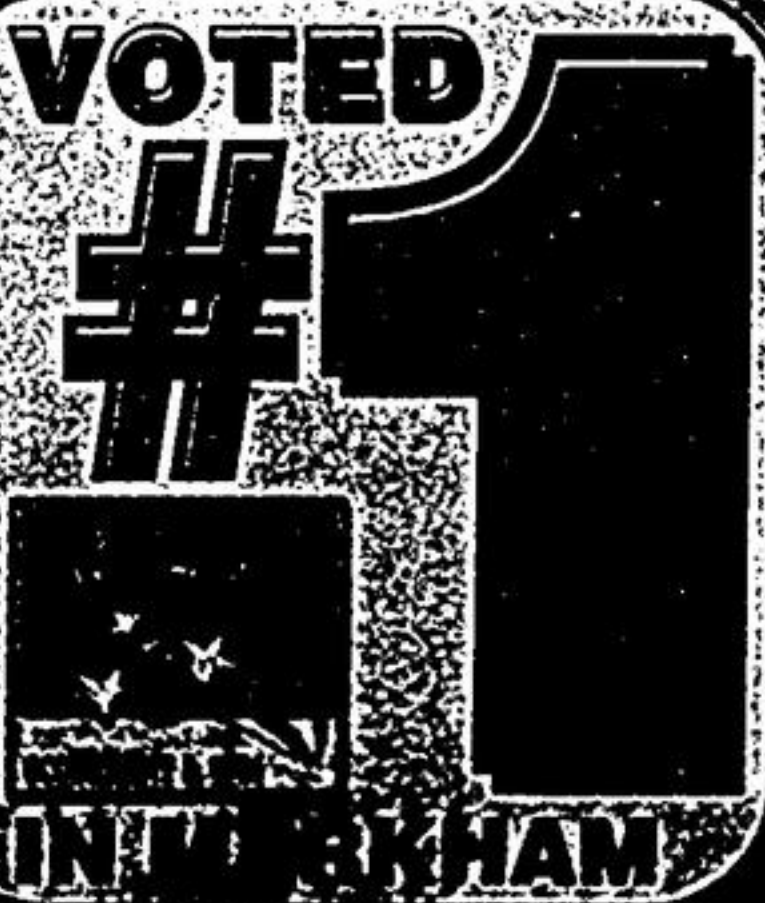
