**Boy hit with BB shot; drug, gun charges laid**

Two Stouffville youths face a string of charges after an 11-year-old boy was hit in the leg by a shot from a BB gun fired out the window of a moving vehicle.

The boy was riding his bike on the Ninth Line, south of Musselman's Lake on Saturday when a car filled with laughing teens drove by.

He thought a stone had hit him until he looked down and realized it was a BB from an air rifle held by someone in the car.

Someone else saw the gun and notified police, who found a vehicle with eight occupants on Hillsdale Drive, south of the lake.

Responding officers could smell a strong scent of marijuana and

searched the car, said Const. Steve Morrell.

They found two air pistols, a switchblade-type knife and 30 individually-wrapped baggies of marijuana in the console.

Six teens, four boys and two girls, were released unconditionally.

Two 19-year-old boys are charged with numerous offences, including drug trafficking, possession of weapons dangerous, discharging a firearm and possession of an illegal substance.
