**SDSS students fighting cancer**

Bright yellow daffodils will appear in several downtown Stouffville locations to kick off the Canadian Cancer Society's April door-to-door campaign.

From Friday, April 4 to Sunday, April 6, volunteers will surround themselves with the cheerful blooms they'll be selling in front of the Canadian Tire, the LCBO outlet, the new A & P grocery store on Main Street and other locations.

This year's daffodil campaign goal is \$50,000, up considerably from the approximately \$40,000 raised in the three-day campaign last year in Whitchurch-Stouffville and Markham.

Students from Stouffville District Secondary School are holding a two-day daffodil blitz, offering flowers for sale before and after school on both Thursday, April 3 and Friday.

This year's door-to-door campaign throughout the month of April is "Be a Face in the Fight Against Cancer".

Many people canvas their neighbourhoods because someone they know is battling or has overcome the disease, noted Katherine Craine, the unit manager of the Markham/Whitchurch-Stouffville unit of the Canadian Cancer Society.

Last year, about 175 canvassers did the rounds in Whitchurch-Stouffville. This year, the society needs at least 90 more people to knock on their neighbour's doors.

Proceeds from the campaigns support the Canadian Cancer Society's programs.

*Artists make cut at Latcham show*

Works by artists from the Whitchurch-Stouffville area were among the 32 pieces of art chosen out of 186 entries for this year's open juried exhibition at the Latcham Gallery in Stouffville.

They include a mixed media/collage work by Frank Smith, Christl Niemuller's watercolour painting and photographs by Heather Banks and James Wilkes.

Some of Mr. Wilkes' photos ran in the Stouffville Sun several years ago while he was still a student at Stouffville District Secondary School.

Ninety-eight artists brought their latest creations, ranging from drawings, watercolours and prints to a 10-foot metal sculpture, to the gallery last week, hoping for a favourable assessment.

Jurors are Margaret Rodgers, curator of the Visual Arts Centre of Clarington, Colin Wiginton, curator and educator at the McLaren Art Centre in Barrie and sculptor Ron Baird, the first director of the Latcham Gallery.

Although the majority of the artists represented are from

York and Durham Regions, residents from Pickering, Barrie, Brighton, the Greater Toronto Area and other locations also travelled to Stouffville to enter their works.

Awards totalling \$1,000 were presented at the show's opening reception on Sunday, March 30. The exhibition continues at the gallery until May 4.

In May, local elementary school students have a chance to showcase their works during a week-long exhibition.
