

Cancer survivors plan third charity run

Survivors of cancer will run to commemorate their victory over Cancer at York Region's Third Annual Relay for Life. The Survivors Victory Lap signifies the beginning of the event, which starts at 7 p.m. June 6 and goes overnight. It will be held at the Markham Fairgrounds at McCowan Road and Elgin Mills Road.

Teams of 10 to 12 people raise pledges and donate them to the Canadian Cancer Society. They take turns running through the night. Many participants also pay tribute to loved ones by lighting candles at the site.

The non-profit Canadian Cancer Society funds research, information services and support programs.

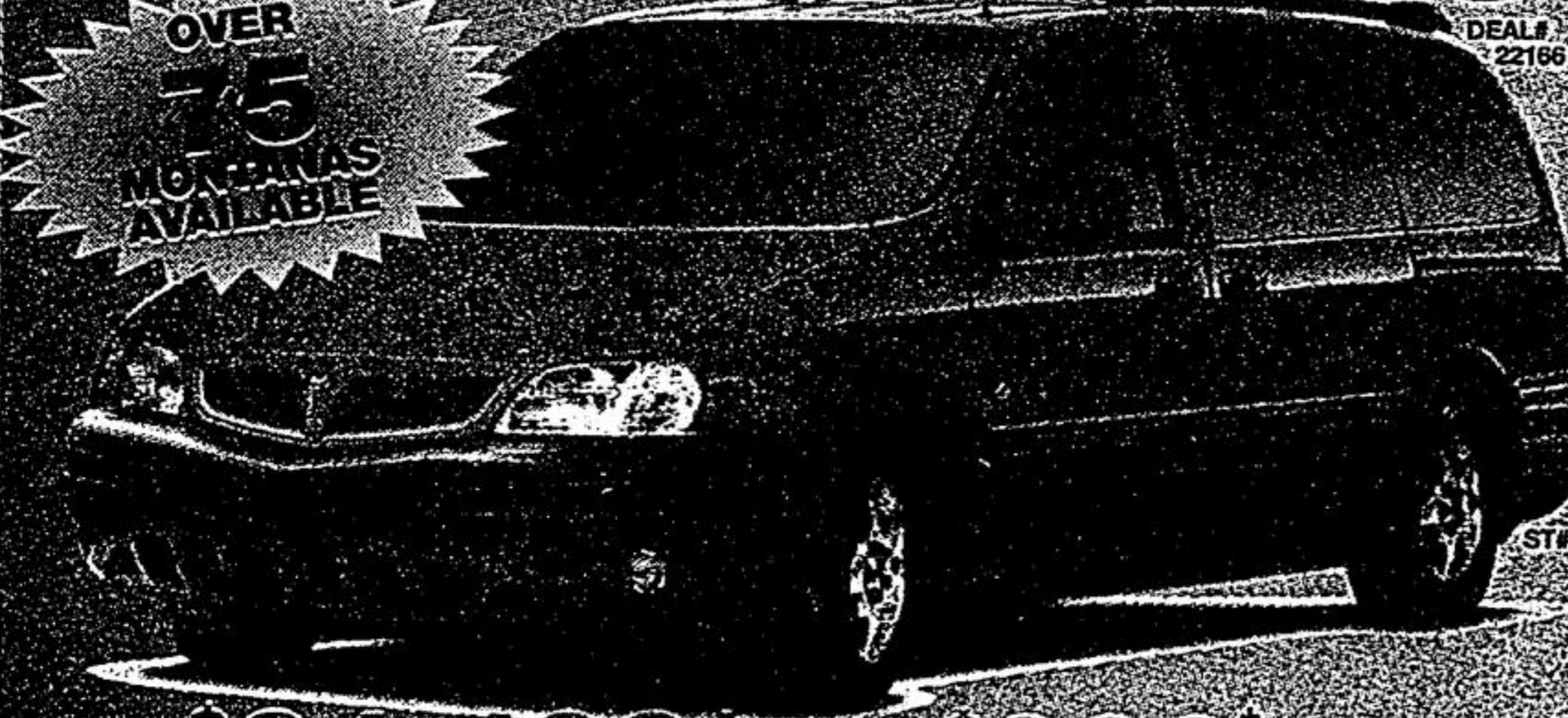

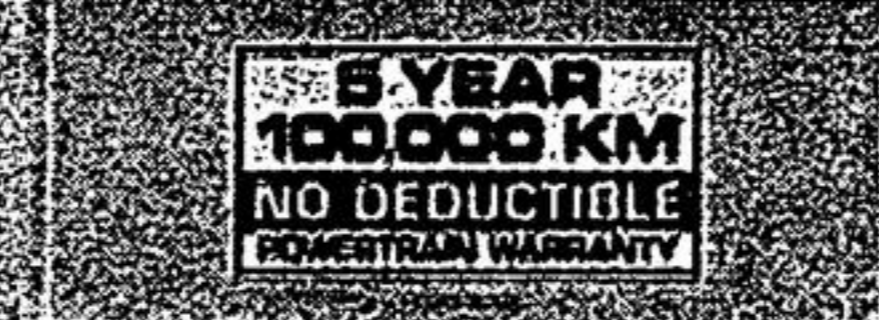
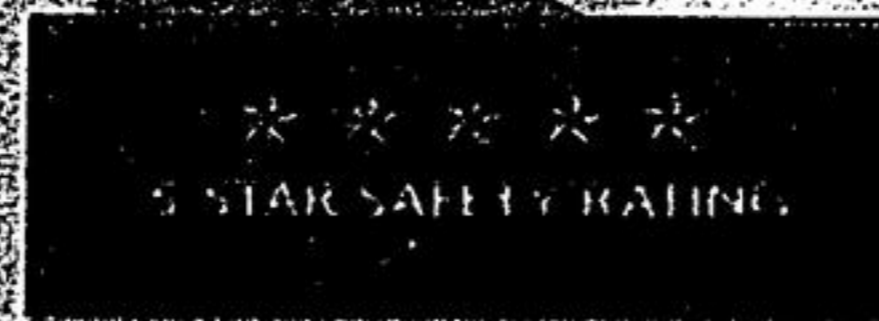
