Weight loss clinic ups food donation

More than 2,500 pounds of canned and non-perishable food have been donated by clients of Curves for Women fitness studio and weight loss clinic on Stouffville's Main Street, topping last year's donations by more than 300 pounds.

A caravan of cars, trucks and vans will be needed by volunteers from Curves to transport the food to the Whitchurch-Stouffville Food Bank in the Musselman's Lake area. Any excess food will be distributed to other food banks in York Region.

This is the time when the food banks run a bit low, explained Curves manager, Sandy Higgs. "This is just a generous community."

The Curves studio, which opened its doors in September 2001, has about 400 members. The Stouffville location came to international attention last month when one of its clients, Sandy Brailey, was named one of six "sweetheart" winners worldwide.

She was recognized for losing more than 60 pounds in one year by following the club's exercise and diet recommendations. She was the only Canadian to receive the award, which came with \$1,000 prize money.

She has been with the club since October 2001.

New magazine for golf club residents

Home on the Green, a new quarterly magazine for residents of the Ballantrae Golf and Country Club, will make its debut April 27.

Editor Ruth Flanagan, a retired English teacher, decided to publish a magazine rather than a newsletter after seeing the wide range of activities and clubs in which local residents were involved.

The first issue will have 40 pages in black and white with a colour cover. It will focus on the almost two dozen interest groups at the adult lifestyle subdivision. Regular columns and features include Neighbour to Neighbour, highlighting local residents and their achievements, Travel Talk, information on day trips, a regular theatre column and a calendar of events in Whitchurch-Stouffville.

"We checked out publications in similar communities," said Mrs. Flanagan, "and went beyond what they are doing." She is working with assistant editor Marna Moldon on the publication, which will be distributed

to 400 households in the subdivision.

The fledgling magazine managed to raise more than \$12,000 in advertising revenues within two months.

The fall issue of the magazine will explore volunteer achievements and the needs of volunteer organizations in Whitchurch-Stouffville and surrounding communities.

This will encourage more business-to-business interaction in the municipality, Mr. Popa believes.
