

# Stouffville midgets move up to men's fastball loop

Stouffville's Jones Pools fastball team have moved up with the big boys this season.

The midget-level club, coached by Ted Assinck and managed by Wayne Dalgarno, is part of the Oshawa City and District League's eastern division and is grouped with two Oshawa teams plus the Claremont Rebels and Scarborough.

Assinck will be relying on the pitching prowess of Greg Dalgarno and Joe German

with Dale Boadway, or Robbie Clayton back of the plate.

The infield includes Rod Assinck (first base), Mike Wilson (second base), Kevin Hayward (third base) and Nick Dambrosio (shortstop).

Patrolling the outfield are Mike Dambrosio, Josh Spang, David Garhard and Andrew Frank. Spang may also be used at second base and Clayton can play any position, adds Assinck.

Shane Timms, Ryan Jackson and Corey Rice are

three overage players that will bolster the club's strength.

The Jones Pools club will once again set its sights on making a run for the Canadian midget championship.


"This level of competition, particularly the pitching, will be tough on us," claims Assinck, who is assisted by Scott Assinck, Tom Hammond and Mike Boadway, "but it's what we need. We're happy to be here."

Making their league debut last Tuesday in Oshawa against the Durham Heat, Stouffville dropped a 6-4 decision.

Playing host to Scarborough in their home debut last Thursday, Stouffville was edged 5-4.

In that contest, Stouffville trailed 5-1 through 5 1/2 innings before mounting a small comeback when Nick Dambrosio was hit by a pitch, Jackson walked and German singled to load the bases. Hayward then forced in a run with a walk and Dalgarno drove in two runs with a ground ball to cut the deficit to 5-4. But that would be as close as they would get.

Stouffville is scheduled to play at Markham Monday and host Oshawa Mickey Finns May 22 at 8:30 p.m.
