Degrassi shoots at skate park, train station

Degrassi: The Next Generation will be set in downtown Stouffville for the start of its third season this fall.

Camera crews, actors and trucks filled with equipment could be seen at various spots in downtown Stouffville yesterday to film parts of the first episode of the new season.

The popular GTV show began as a spin-off from the *Degrassi High* series of the late 1980s, exploring the adolescent trials and tribulations of a group of young teens. The daughter of "Spike", a character from the earlier series, has now grown up to become one of the central charac-

ters of the new programs, Emma Nelson. She is played by 15-year-old Toronto actress Miriam McDonald. She and Craig Manning, portrayed by actor Jake Epstein, are the main protagonists in "The Father Figure".

TICKET TO STOUFFVILLE

In one scene, Emma buys a ticket to come to Stouffville to visit her father. The BIA office was used to portray the ticket office. "We liked the look of Stouffville. The Main Street has a nice country feel to it," said Anthony Kadak, the show's location manager. "Everyone has been very accommodating."

The show, which has the Degrassi

teens attending the newly-refurbished Degrassi Community School, is set and shot entirely in Southern Ontario. Most of the scenes are filmed on a set in downtown Toronto. Out of the 88 shoot days for each season, only eight are on location. The show will also be filmed at Shouldice Hospital in Thornhill, at a beach in Bluffer's Park and on Eglinton Avenue in downtown Toronto.

About 100 crew members and a number of large trucks descended on the Over the Edge skateboard park, at a house on Church Street and at the Stouffville Train Station for more than 12 hours yesterday.
