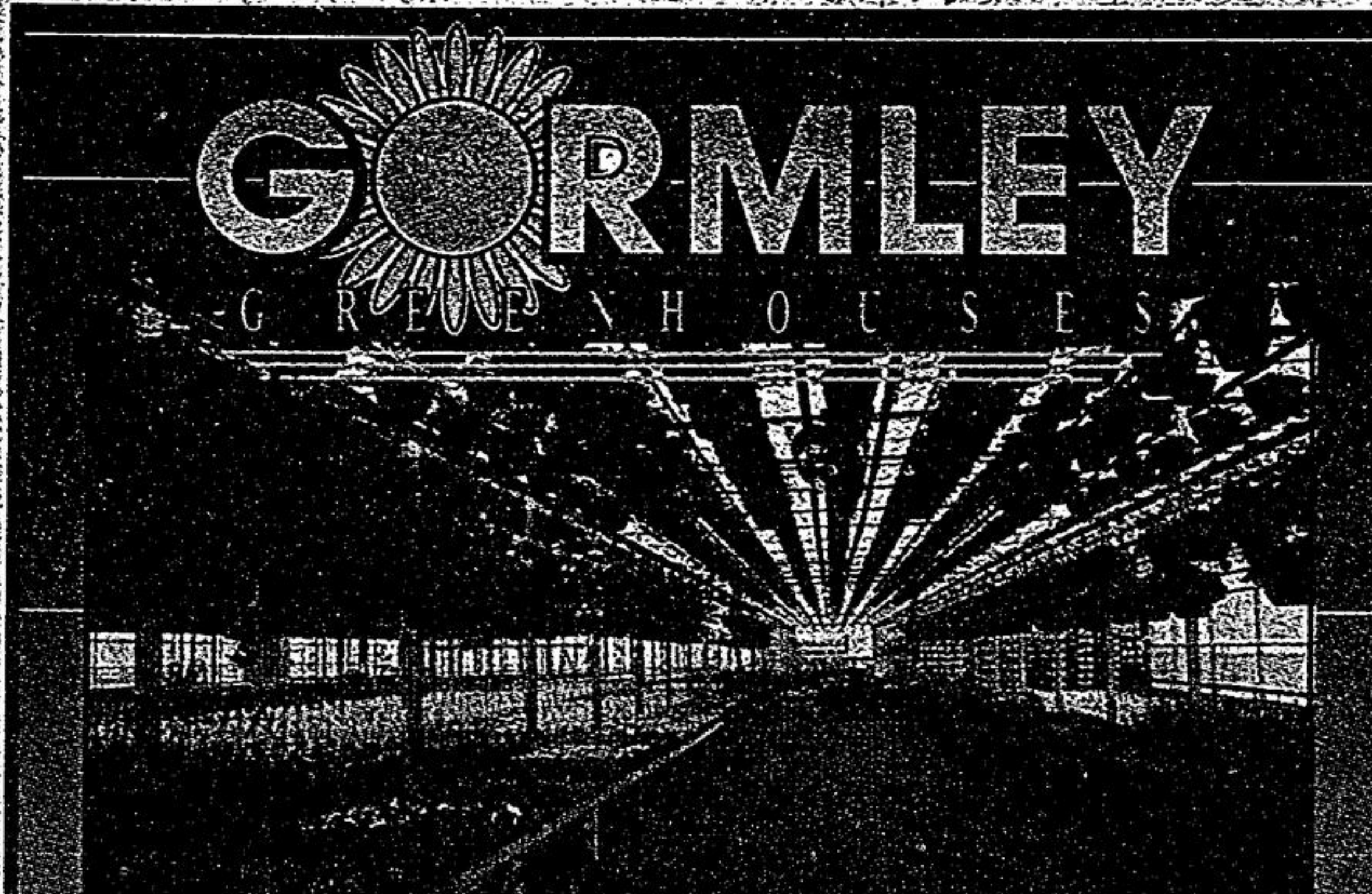

Elvises return to Stouffville

Stouffville's Main Street will be the scene of combs, pomades and curling lips as Elvis tribute artists gather for the town's second annual Elvisfest, June 13 and 14.

About 26 of the performers will be at the Stouffville Train Station from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. Friday, according to Ruth LeBlanc, who co-ordinated the event. Poodle skirts will be making a fashion come-back as The Memphis Motion Dancers, the Dance Time Road Show from Uxbridge and students from the CentreLine Studio in Stouffville strut their moves to kick off the festivities.

This year's Elvises include "Little Elvis", Bob Hayes from Barbados, Paul Ross, who has won championships at Collingwood's Elvis Festival, Selvis who returns with a back-up band and Jimmy Walton, also known as "King Creole".

A barbecue will be provided by the Clever Conductor on Main Street, where the Elvises will gather afterwards. They'll also visit the Earl of Whitchurch and the Emerald Isle pubs on Main Street in downtown Stouffville.

Saturday's all-day downtown event starts with a rumble as The Motor Maids, an all-women's motorcycle club, join Elvis performers in a parade starting from the Stouffville Train Station at 11 a.m. The performers and '50s dancers will be riding in vintage and classic cars.

Entertainment starts at noon and continues into the evening on two stages — at the Stouffville Train Station and in the town square on Civic Avenue. Trivia and dance contests will be held. Last year, around 1,200 people attended the festival.
