Law firm wins challenge

Local law firm Wilson Vukelich LLP took on the Town of Markham last week and won.

Employees at the firm beat town workers at Pollution Probe's Clean Air Commute, a week-long annual contest that encourages people to leave cars at home and carpool, bicycle or walk to work.

The firm's lawyers didn't take part but 11 of 13 staff members did.

"It's a good excuse to get your bike out of the garage and come to work on it," said

Valerie Tetmar, a legal assistant from Ballantrae, who drove to Unionville, but rode a bicycle the rest of the way.

The town, which already promotes trip-reduction for its employees, had 58 participants out of 700 full-time staff. "We probably haven't done great," said Lorenzo Mele, who co-ordinates travel demand management programs for the town.

Still, he noted some employees changed habits during a week when smog warnings were in effect.
