Golf remains fun for Streit

Marlene Streit said she hadn't played competitive golf in Ontario for the last five years. But judging by the way the 69-year-old former Whitchurch-Stouffville resident performed in last week's Ontario Senior Ladies Amateur Golf Championship at the Dalewood Golf and Curling Club in Port Hope, it looked as if she hadn't missed a beat. Now residing in Unionville, Streit captured her sixth Ontario Senior Ladies Amateur title last Thursday after carding a final round 78, good enough for a three-shot margin of victory over Mary Lou Henderson of Kingsville. Streit finished the three-day, 54-hole event at 10-over par 226 (76-72-78).

"I just felt like taking some time off, I've still played competitively in Florida (during the winter months where she maintains a home)," said Streit, a member of the York Downs Golf and Country Club in Unionville where she now lives. "It feels great (to win); I just love to play."

Streit credited her latest triumph to an ability to putt consistently in the final round. "I made a lot of putts during the first two rounds, but today was a little different. I missed a few, there were some tough pin positions," said Streit, who uses a 50-year-old putter that she borrowed from Gord McInnis Sr., her mentor and former head pro at Lookout Point Country Club where she developed her other skills.

"I'm still using it, I use it at mostly all the championships I play in," she revealed. In winning the title, Streit along with the other top three competitors will represent Team Ontario at the Canadian Senior Ladies Amateur Championships and Canadian Inter-Provincial Team Championships at the Galt Country Club in Cambridge from Aug. 25-28.

For Streit, who was born in Cereal, Alta., in 1934, her victory represents the 19th provincial championship she has won in her storied amateur career on the fairways. Of her more than 35 significant amateur victories throughout the world, she lists the 1956 U.S. Women's Amateur, 1953 British Women's Amateur and 1951 Canadian Ladies' Amateur as her three most memorable victories.

She is also a four-time Canadian female athlete of the year and a two-time Lou Marsh Trophy Winner as Canada's athlete of the year.

Disappointing racing weekend for Macri

Jonathan Macri's appearance at the Toyota Atlantic race last weekend in Trois-Rivieres could be summed up in one word — disappointment. After recording one of the best times during the provisional qualifier, the 21-year-old Gormley resident damaged his main vehicle and was forced to use a backup for the feature race and finished seventh.

"We obviously are disappointed in our performance this weekend," Macri said. "It is frustrating because we came into the race with a good car and then when we had to switch to the backup, and it just wasn't handling as well. I have a great team though and they are working really hard to make the repairs and get the car ready for Mid-Ohio," he added in reference to his next race this weekend in Lexington, Ohio.

Macri's demise came during qualifying when he made the mistake of going too wide coming into the front straightaway and made hard contact with the outside wall. With the damage to his vehicle being extensive, Macri was forced to use a backup car for the remainder of the weekend, thus eliminating his qualifying times and an opportunity to start on the grid within the top five drivers.

Starting the feature race on the street course from the eighth position, Macri was able to manoeuvre into the seventh spot by the 17th lap and held that position until the race concluded.

With Sunday's finish, Macri continues to hold down third place in the overall standings with 103 points and is just 11 behind second-place Ryan Dalziel.

Mennos' win streak at seven
