Notice is hereby given to all residents of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville that the Voters' List, which includes the names of all persons entitled to vote at the Municipal Elections, is available for viewing effective September 2nd, 2003. Voters are advised to examine the list.

**HOW DO YOU CHECK THE LIST? IT'S EASY.**

If you are 18 years old or will attain the age of 18 years on or before November 10th, 2003, a Canadian Citizen, and are the owner or tenant of property, or the spouse or same sex partner of such owner or tenant - check the Voters' List to see if your name has been included. Please note that businesses that are incorporated are prohibited from voting.

If your name is not included, and you are a qualified elector, you can have your name added to the list by completing the necessary application at the Clerk's Department, Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, 37 Sandiford Drive, Stouffville. Likewise if there are any other corrections, omissions or deletions that should be made to the list, these too can be made by completing the necessary application at the Clerk's Department.

Residents should also check to see if their school support is correctly shown. It should be noted that you **MUST BE** Roman Catholic in order to be eligible to vote for the English Language Catholic District School Board Trustee and you **MUST HAVE** French language rights and **BE** Roman Catholic in order to be eligible to vote for the French Language Catholic District School Board Trustee.

Revisions to the list may be made commencing Tuesday, September 2nd through to Wednesday, November 5th, 2003 at the Clerk's Department during regular office hours - Monday to Friday, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Revisions will also be accepted at the Advance Votes being held on:  
Saturday, November 1st (10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)  
Monday, November 3rd (4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.)
