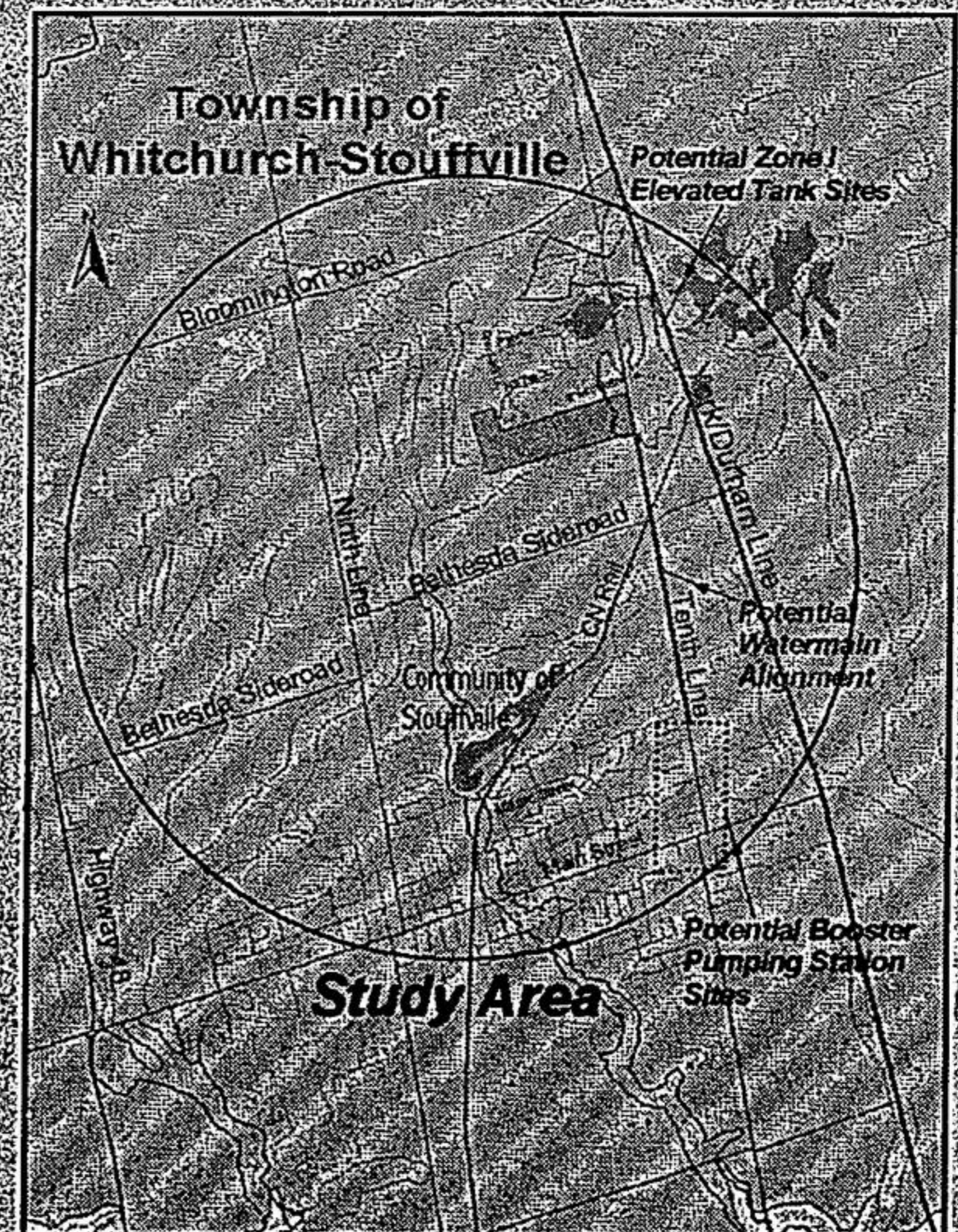

An expansion to the existing water distribution system is necessary to enable The Regional Municipality of York to meet future water servicing requirements created by ongoing population and employment growth in the Town of Stouffville. The Region is therefore undertaking a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to determine preferred sites for a new elevated water storage tank, booster pumping station, and trunk watermain. A preferred location will be determined based on the information gathered during the study, engineering requirements, environmental considerations, and from public input. The Region has retained MacViro Consultants Inc. to assist in completing the study.
