

Artist Lumbers signs in at Stouffville gallery

Famous Canadian artist James Lumbers visits the Golden Eagle Art Gallery in Stouffville Sunday.

Residents can bring their favourite prints, framed or unframed, and books for the artist to sign between 1 and 3 p.m. The gallery is at 18 Ringwood Dr., Unit 1. The gallery will have an extensive collection of the artist's work, including his newest painting, which is being shown for the first time.

Although he began as a wildlife artist, Mr. Lumbers' latest works feature nostalgic images within his compositions. A painting showing a mother with her about-to-be-married daughter also has a more subtle image of the grandmother in the background.

Unusual prints and paintings by printmakers Elena Roginsky and Karen Curry take viewers through time at Stouffville's Latcham Gallery until Sunday, Sept. 21.

From the Shadows features Karen

Curry's large paintings of an overturned Inuit boat. She begins by painting on the wood surface and then sanding and painting again to continually remove from and add to the image. She achieves textured paintings that reflect the passage of time and the erosion of the subject itself.

Elena Roginsky's etchings are pulled from huge plates. This artist captures brief moments as if they are frozen in time, whether they're a quiet part of a child's day or from a more chaotic happening.
