Park construction could start in 2005

meeting regarding the new parkland is slated for spring 2004.

The earliest anything could be built on the parcel is 2005. The site is also available if additional ball diamonds are needed to replace Diamonds 2 and 3 in Memorial Park.

They are slated for removal once the sewage treatment plant is decommissioned in late 2004 or early 2005 and Park Drive South is extended south.

Councillor Carroll stated there are currently two ball diamonds, in Vandorf and Ballantrae, "that we take care of on an annual basis, but we don't use."

New church given council go-ahead

Stouffville Missionary Church received the go-ahead from Whitchurch-Stouffville council last week to construct a new building.

The sod has been officially turned on the approximately five-acre site south of the Stouffville Country Market on Tenth Line.

With membership growing rapidly, the congregation decided larger quarters, with more parking spaces, were needed to serve both its own members and the community.

The current church on

Main Street is for sale. "This is a good news story," Mayor Wayne Emmerson said. "It is going to be a great facility to be used by many residents."

The two-storey, 50,979-square-foot building is to include a 589-seat church sanctuary, a gym, kitchen, library, meeting rooms, a nursery, offices, washrooms and several classrooms. A parking lot east of the church will provide space for 270 vehicles.

A seniors residential community is proposed to the south and east of the church site. Driveways north and south of the church will be shared by the two proposed developments.
