

# Dimovski had 'no relationship' with Tsubouchi

his appearance before the Management Board Secretariat's standing committee on government agencies, which reports back to the legislature on whether or not it concurs with potential appointments.

Mr. Dimovski told the committee he had "no relationship" with Mr. Tsubouchi but had spoken to Mr. Tsubouchi's executive assistant regarding the position.

"I asked if they would have any difficulties with me applying for this position and they encouraged me to do so," he told the committee, according to Hansard transcripts.

At the time, Mr. Dimovski was vice-president of Markham's federal Liberal association, a position he resigned after his appointment as Ontario's Public Service Act demands political neutrality for tribunal adjudicators.

Mr. Dimovski informed the committee he was no

longer a member of the provincial Liberals.

Mr. Tsubouchi, chairperson of the Management Board of Cabinet and Minister of Culture, was not immediately able to comment on the appointment, said D'Arcy Pigott, his campaign chairperson.

Mr. Dimovski said he could not comment.

During his campaign for the Liberal nomination last year, he told The Economist & Sun many of the new Liberals he had signed up lived in the Main Street,

Markham area — where support for Mr. Tsubouchi has been particularly strong.

After Mr. Wong was selected as the Liberal candidate, Mr. Dimovski said he submitted more than 1,000 memberships in one delivery to the party last June.

At that time, he said he did not know if he could "carry" them over to Mr. Wong.

"I'm just going to let them do what they think is proper," he said.
