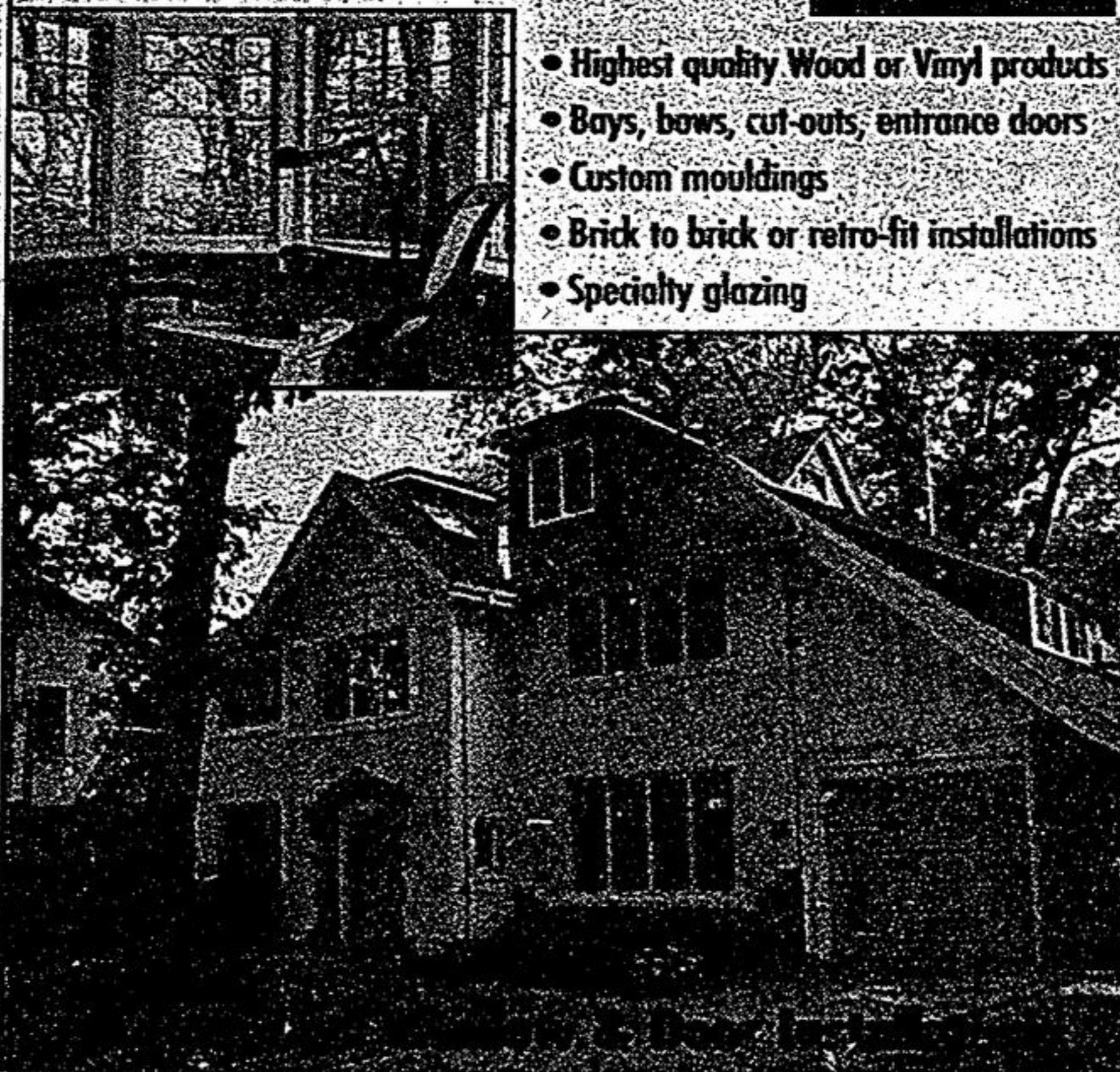

Local walkers
in giant
cancer
fundraiser

A total of 135 walkers and volunteers from Markham and Stouffville took part in the first Weekend to End Breast Cancer last month in Toronto.

The local contingent, aged 16 to 60, was among 3,972 people who took part in the two-day, 60 km event.

They walked 30 km the first day and used about 2,000 tents to camp out at Downsview Park.

The second leg was completed the next day at Exhibition Place.

Each participant raised a minimum of \$2,000. In total, the event raised about \$12 million. It is being called the largest first-year event in Canada's fundraising history.

All proceeds go to breast cancer research, education, screening and treatment at Princess Margaret Hospital in Toronto.
