as it has a constant temperature," he said.

Not only is he the product specialist at Festa Juice, he has been a wine-making hobbyist for the past 18 years.

"I like to try different things," he said. "I drink two or three glasses with dinner every night, so I can't afford to pay \$12 a bottle."

Places such as Festa Juice and Wine Kitz offer everything a

home winemaker needs: carboys, bottles, varieties of corks and stoppers, labels, thermometers and even oak chips to give wine an oak cask flavour. The savings on the first batch of wine can go a long way to paying for the equipment.

Mr. Valente had one piece of advice for anyone trying his or her hand at wine making.

"Follow the procedures and don't take short cuts," he said. "Understand what's happening all through the process."
