We've got one more shipment (the last) of these great apples from the Okanagan Valley. They are a great eating apple. From British Columbia

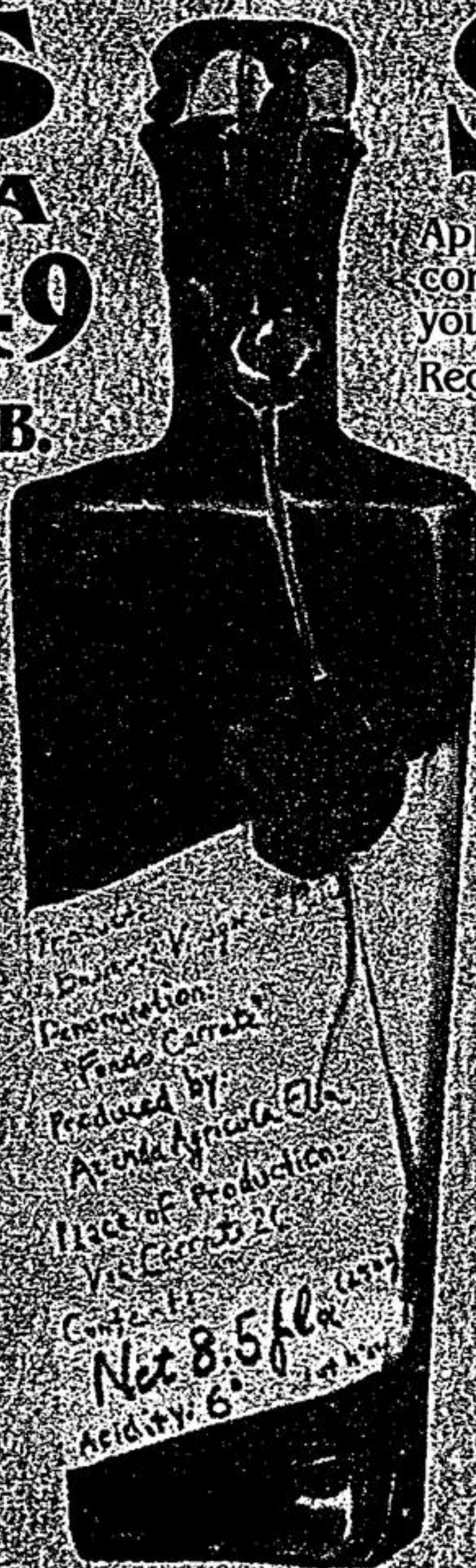

WE'VE MADE A FEW CHANGES...

- (3) we'll be able to have an all day long presentation with a good amount more variety. The end result will be a better quality offering — and more of it!

CHICKEN CUTLETS

This is one of our more popular meat counter preparations. We begin with our chicken breasts and flatten them so they'll cook quickly. We then bread them with egg crumbs and a French herb seasoning — and voila! — a quick and tasty meal that can be served on a bun or on a plate with your veggies (and fries).
