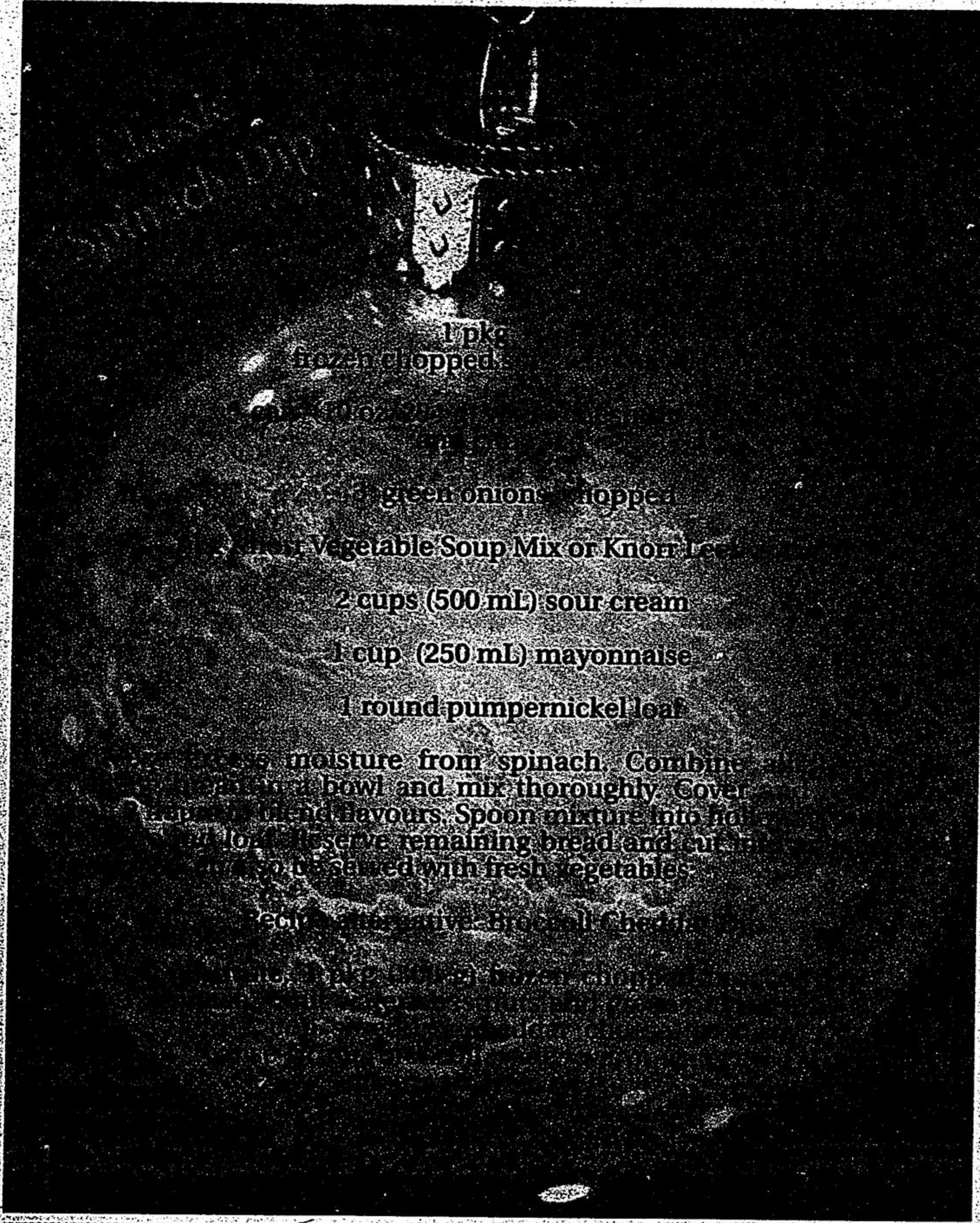

- 1 pkg frozen chopped spinach

- 1/2 cup (125 mL) frozen chopped green onions
- 1/2 cup (125 mL) frozen Vegetable Soup Mix or Knorr Vegetable Soup Mix
- 2 cups (500 mL) sour cream
- 1 cup (250 mL) mayonnaise
- 1 round pumpernickel loaf

Remove moisture from spinach. Combine spinach, onions and soup mix in a bowl and mix thoroughly. Cover and refrigerate overnight. Spoon mixture into holes in loaf. Reserve remaining bread and cut into slices. Loaf can also be served with fresh vegetables.

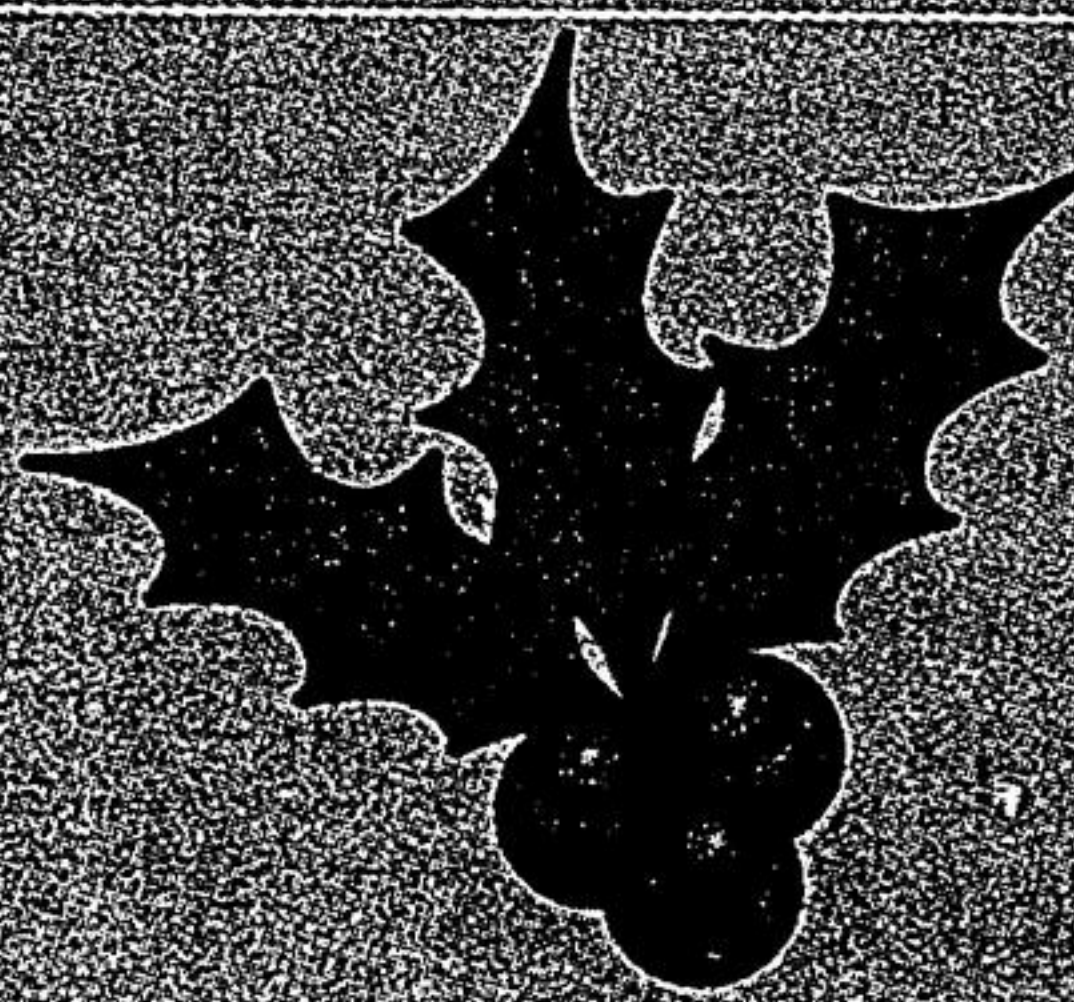
