

# Macri motors on to Champ Cars

Jonathan Macri is entering a new world in the sport of auto racing.

The 21-year-old Gormley resident is in Sebring, Fla., testing for Walker Racing in the world of Champ Cars at Sebring International Raceway.

For Macri, it's the first time he's been behind the wheel of a Champ Car and he's looking forward to the challenge that awaits him after competing three years in the Toyota Atlantic Series.

"I'm really looking forward to testing for Walker Racing. It couldn't have happened at a better time. I really enjoyed racing the Atlantic Series and

I've learned a lot, but I think it's time to move on," he said.

## BIGGER, FASTER CARS

Macri notes the biggest difference between Champ Cars and those in the Toyota Atlantic series is the weight of the vehicles and power behind them. Champ Cars, he said, are heavier and faster.

"There's an additional 300 pounds of weight and a 500-horsepower differential between Atlantic and Champ Cars, so it should be interesting to see how I do," Macri said before leaving. "I'll be clocking a total of 200 miles each day, so I've been working hard to make sure I'm physically prepared."

"Testing will give Walker Racing a chance to gauge my performance and it will also give all of us a chance to see how well we work together, how well we gel. It's definitely a good start, something to work from that may develop into a ride next year or open up some more doors in the Champ Car Series."

Although Macri intends to race in the Champ Car series, he will continue to work with his sponsor from the Toyota Atlantic Series, NTN Bearings Corp.
