**GEORGINA TRANSFER STATION**

Residents are able to drop off additional household garbage, large articles or home improvement material (disposal fee applies) at the Georgina Transfer Station located at 23068 Warden Avenue (just north of Ravenshoe Road) Monday to Saturday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. **ORGANIC COMPOSTING FACILITY**

PLEASE NOTE that as of January 1st, 2004 the Organic Yard Waste Composting Facility on Bloomington Road in Richmond Hill will no longer be available to residents of York Region. Residents may deliver yard waste to York Region's Waste Transfer Station in Georgina, 23068 Warden Avenue (just north of Ravenshoe Road).
