Bantam Clippers advance to OMHA semifinals

Stouffville sweeps Barrie in best-of-three quarter-final series

The Stouffville bantam A Clippers exploded for four third-period goals to defeat Barrie 4-1 Sunday at the Stouffville Arena and clinch their best-of-five Ontario Minor Hockey Association quarter-final series in three games.

Excellent goaltending from Brad Wittingstall and an outstanding effort from the defence corps of Michael Bigioni, Ryne Parsons, Andrew Stewart, Corey Thompson and Richard Downing enabled the Clippers to overcome early penalty problems and keep the game close through two periods.



Ken Czerwinski, Nathan James, Sam O'Farrell and Mitchell Raithby scored for Stouffville.

The victory over Barrie marked the third consecutive series sweep for the Clippers, who previously defeated

Aurora and Markham.

One of the keys to success has been a balanced attack that has averaged four goals a game. Nick Stratus leads the team with seven goals, followed by Ken Higgins and James each with five and Czerwinski and Matt Easter with four each. Brendan Wise, Raithby and O'Farrell have each scored three times while Justin Lacey has six assists. The goaltending tandem of Wittingstall and Justin Gaudet sports a combined 1:22 goals against average.

The Clippers will play in the OMHA semifinals against either Ajax or Cobourg.

Mite selects prep for playoffs with win over Vaughan

The Stouffville mite select Clippers tuned up for the upcoming playoffs by earning a tie and victory in recent minor hockey action.

Taking to the road for a game against the Pickering Panthers, the Clippers received goals from Jeremy Hughes and Tyler Ryan to earn a 2-2 draw.

In another road encounter, against the Vaughan Blue Rangers, the Clippers received two goals from Taylor Peterson and singles from Hughes and Ryan to skate off with a 4-1 win.

Scott Carrick and Ryan Dunlop earned assists.

Andrew Riopel played two strong games in net for the Clippers, who face the Panthers in a best-of-five first round playoff series starting today.
